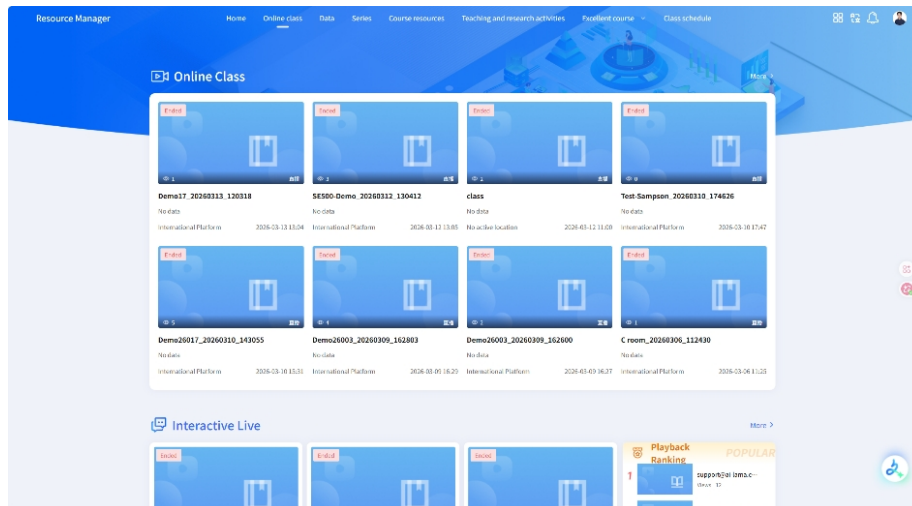

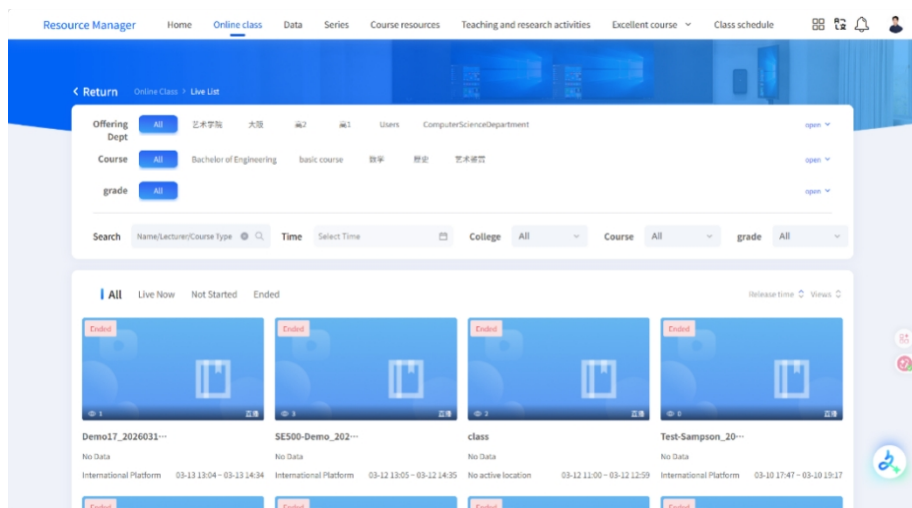
The homepage displays live events, interactive live streams, teaching and research activities, series courses, premium courses, and news announcements.

The online classroom includes two modules: online classroom and interactive live broadcast



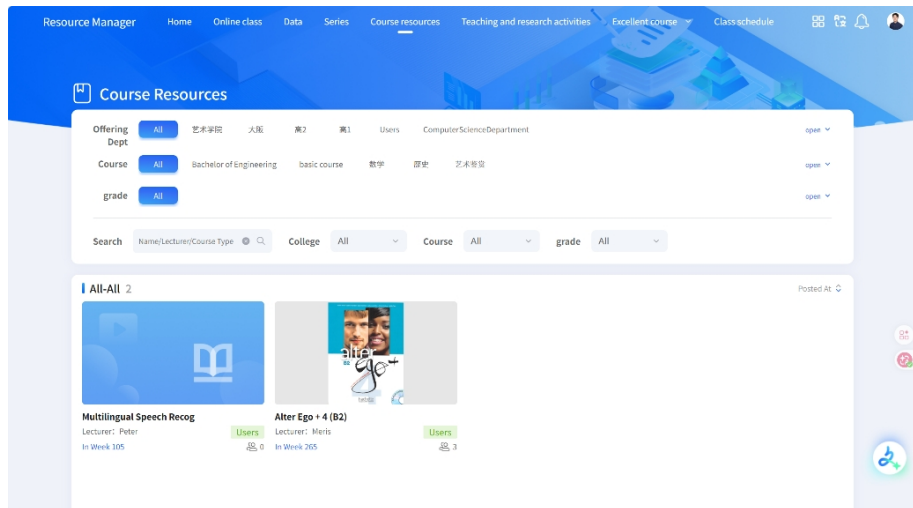

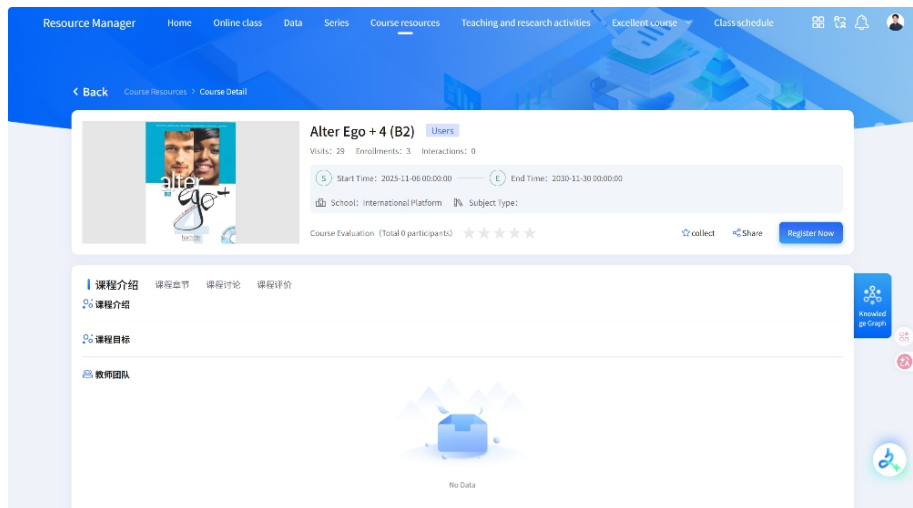

Course resources can be filtered by department, subject type, or grade, or searched by course name, instructor, or course type. You can also sort them in ascending or descending order by publication date.



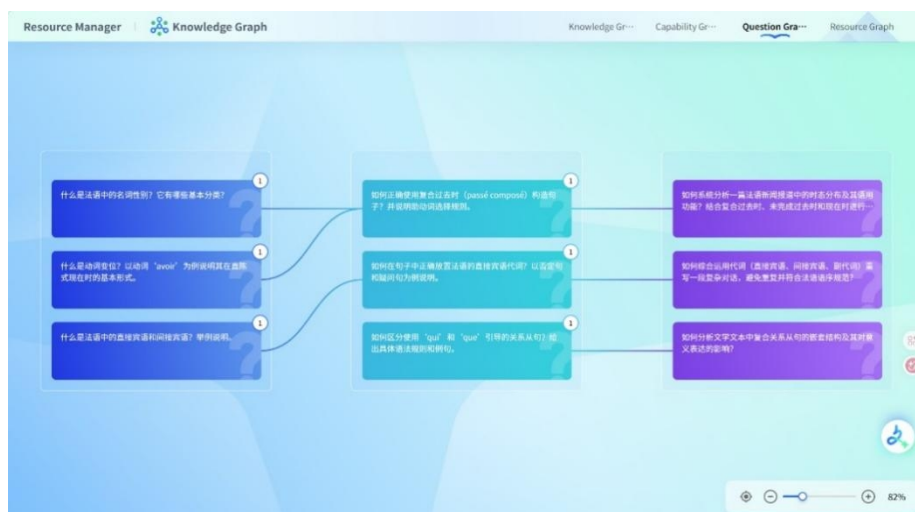

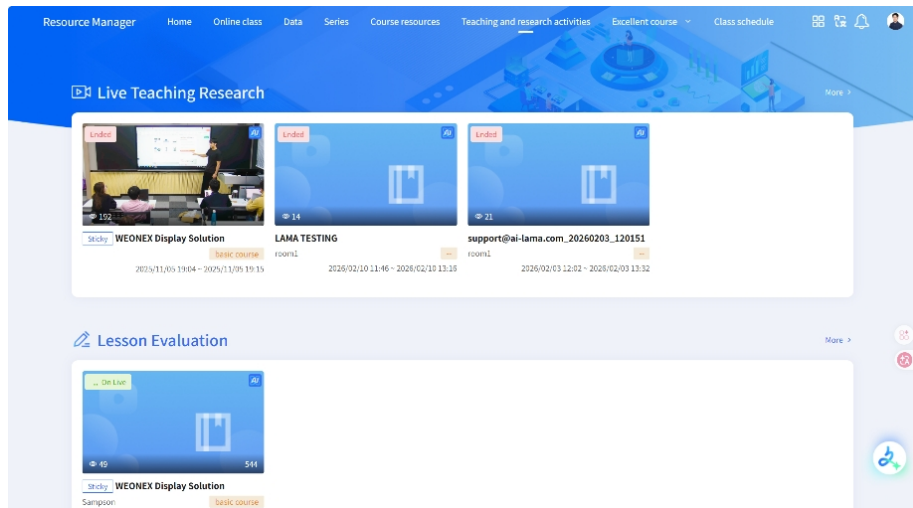

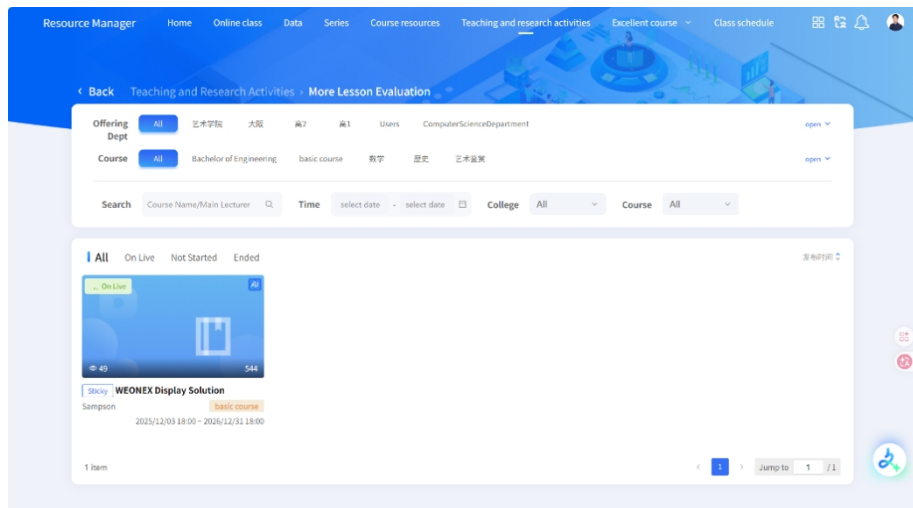

Teaching and research activities consist of four modules: lesson evaluation, live-streamed teaching research, interactive teaching research, and teaching research groups.

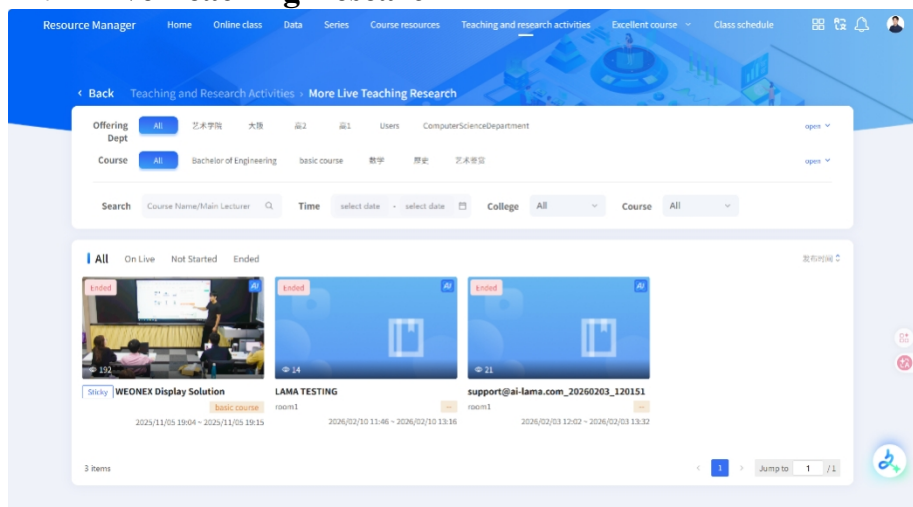

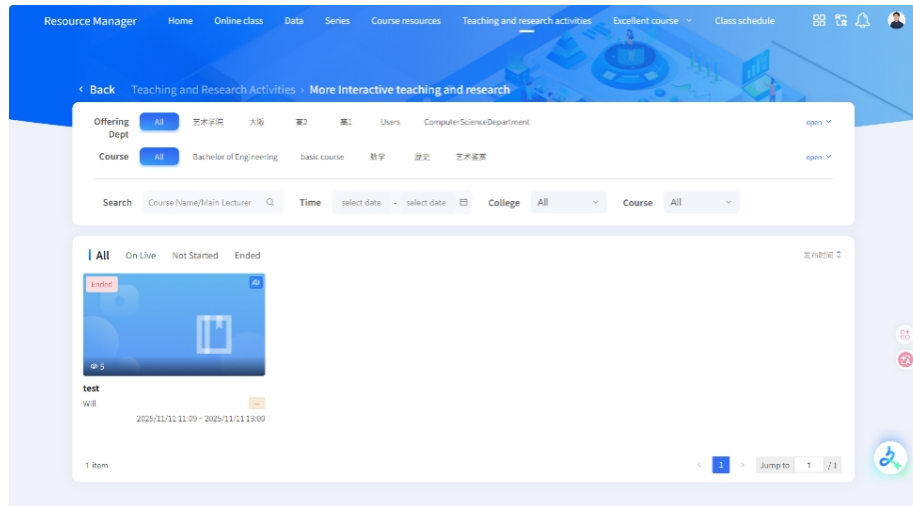

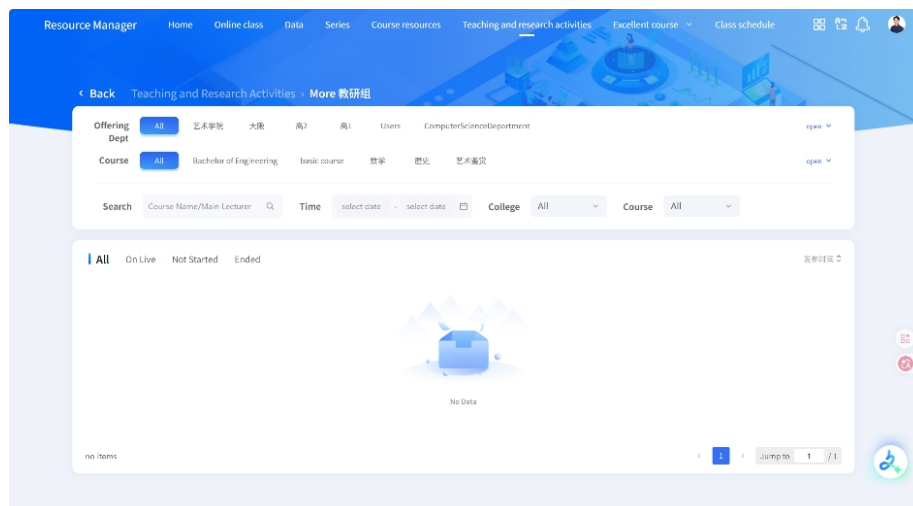

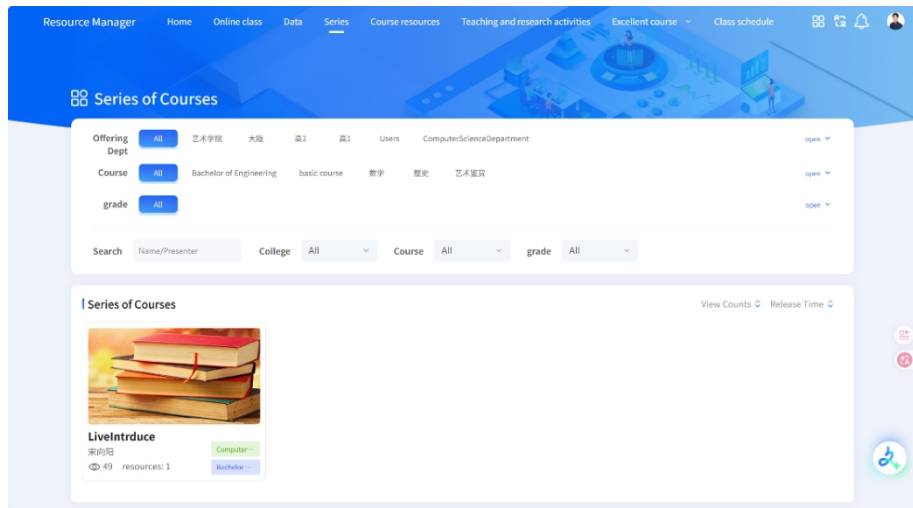

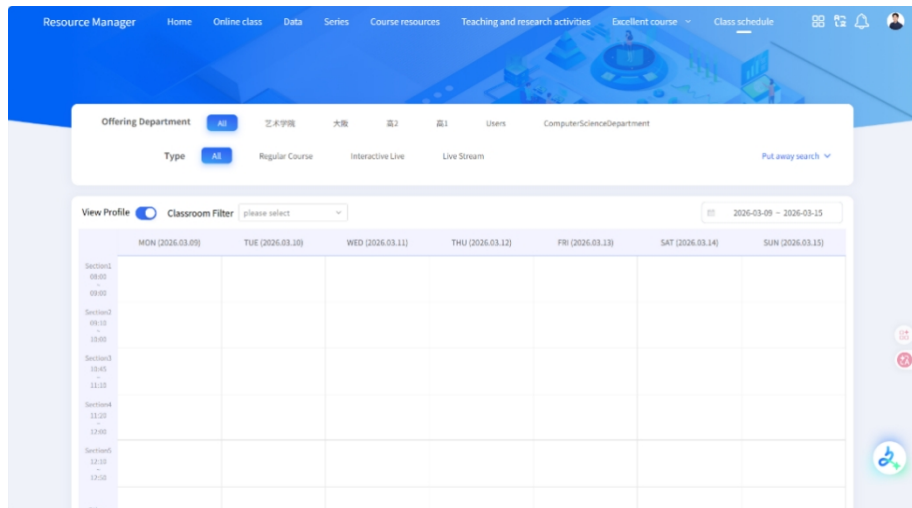
The series supports filtering by department, course category, grade, instructor, or course name. You can also sort the results in ascending or descending order by view count or release date.

6、Premium Courses



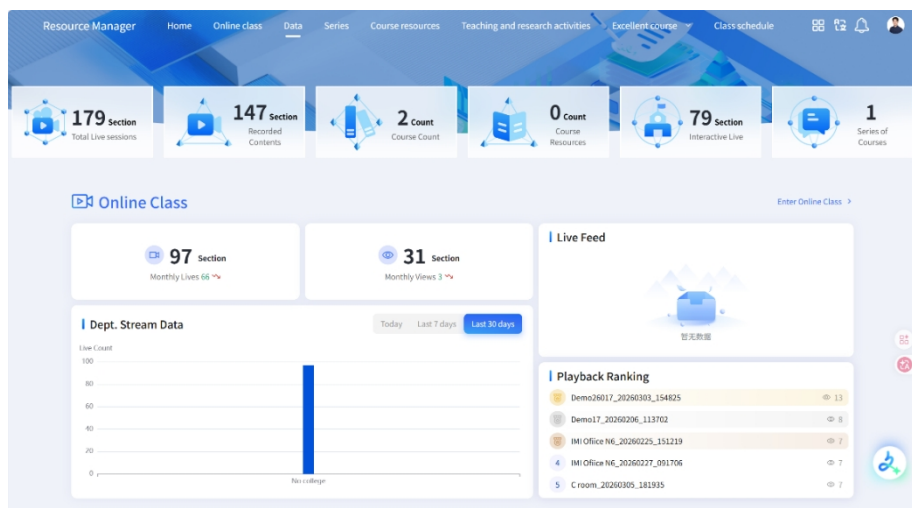

The data section provides users with multi-dimensional platform operation statistics, including:

3. Statistics on the total number of premium courses, this month's premium courses, and this week's premium courses;
4. Total number of created course resources, total number of published course resources, number of publishers, and number of subscribers;
5. Total number of teaching and research activities (including lesson evaluations, live teaching sessions, and interactive workshops), viewership figures, participating teachers, and total teaching and research groups;
6. Server resource utilization ratio, resource usage rate (calculated as: total published videos divided by total platform-supported videos multiplied by 100%), and video storage capacity

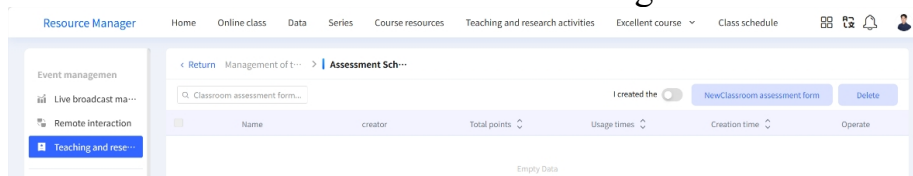

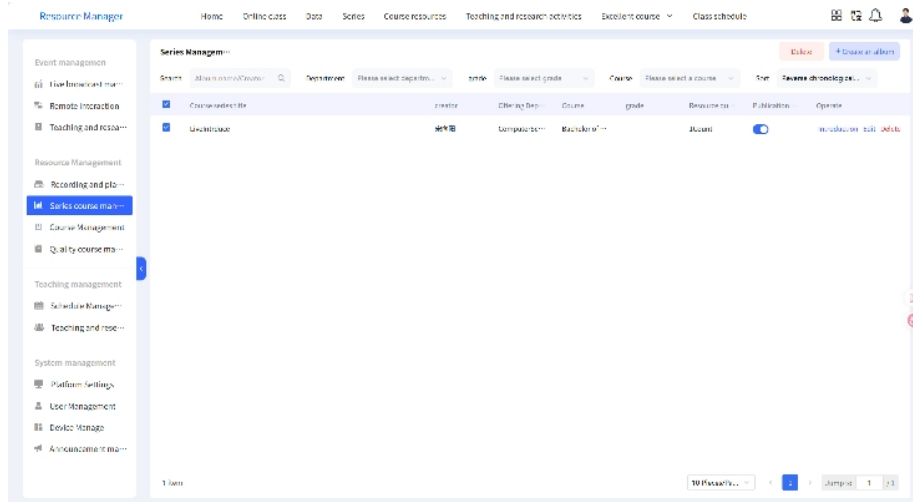

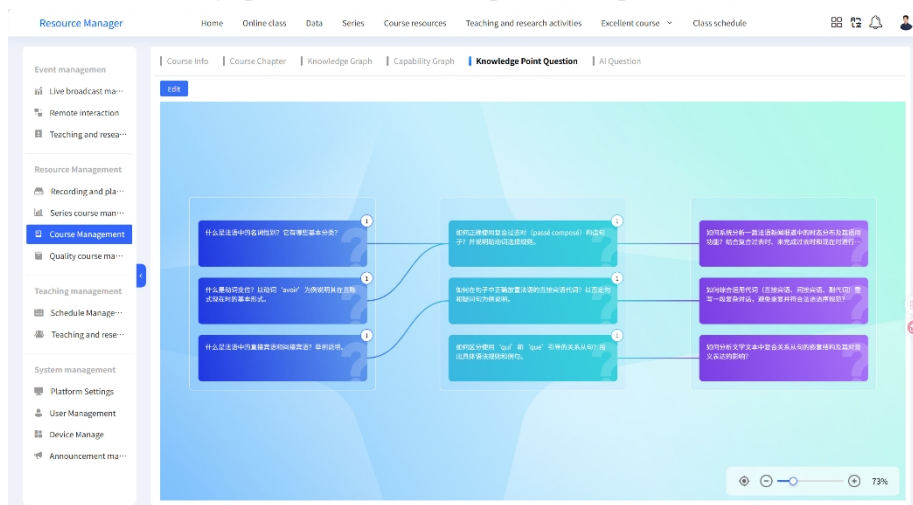

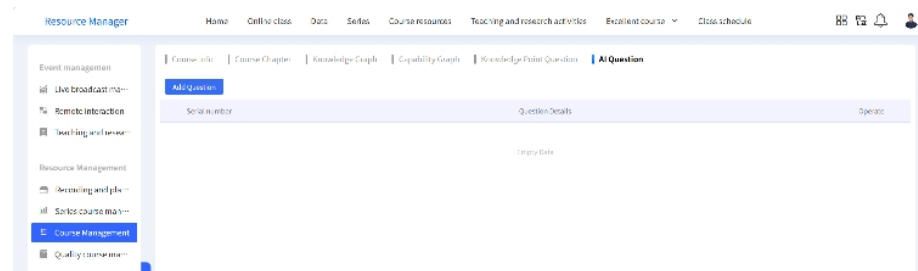


You can also modify the name of a competency map, delete a competency map, associate knowledge points, and add a competency map directory.

Click Edit to add, delete, or modify questions for knowledge points.



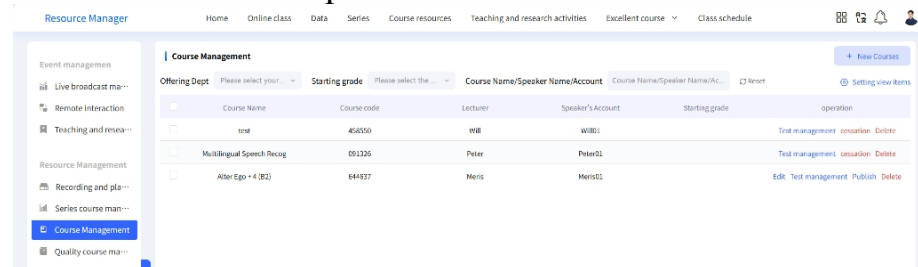

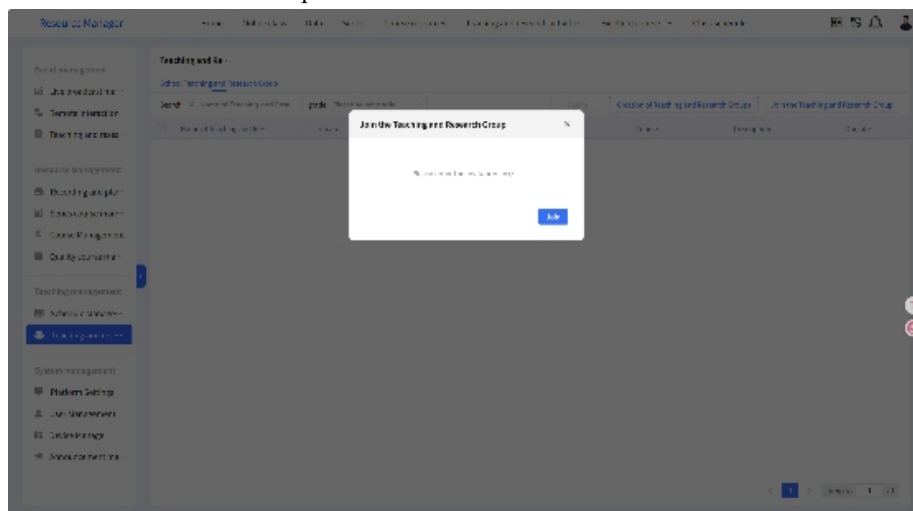

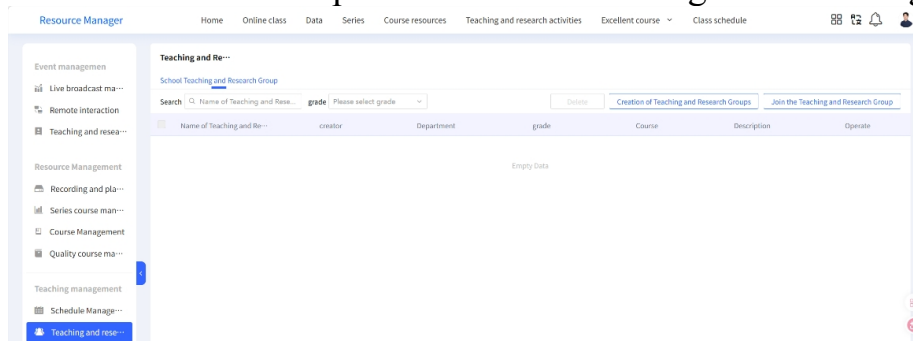

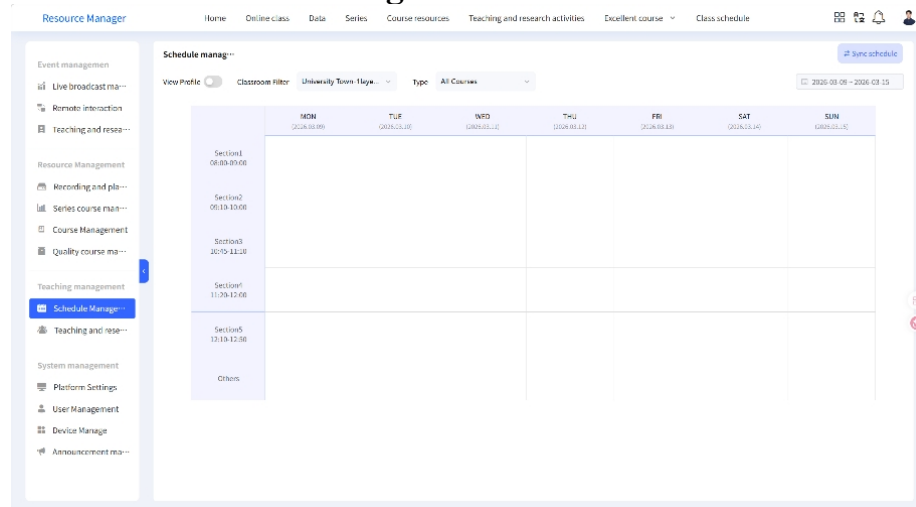
This user will join directly if they join through the teaching and research group account or invitation link. The application list supports searching by name or course keywords, and you can approve or ignore application records in batches.

Clicking the [Share] button will open a sharing dialog box containing the teaching and research group ID, invitation link, and QR code. Other users can join the group through any of these methods.

Click [More] to see the [Dissolve] and [Edit] buttons. Click [Edit] to modify the basic information of the teaching and research group. Click [Dissolve] to delete the group permanently.

Clicking the teaching and research group name displays its members. You can add, delete, or search for members.

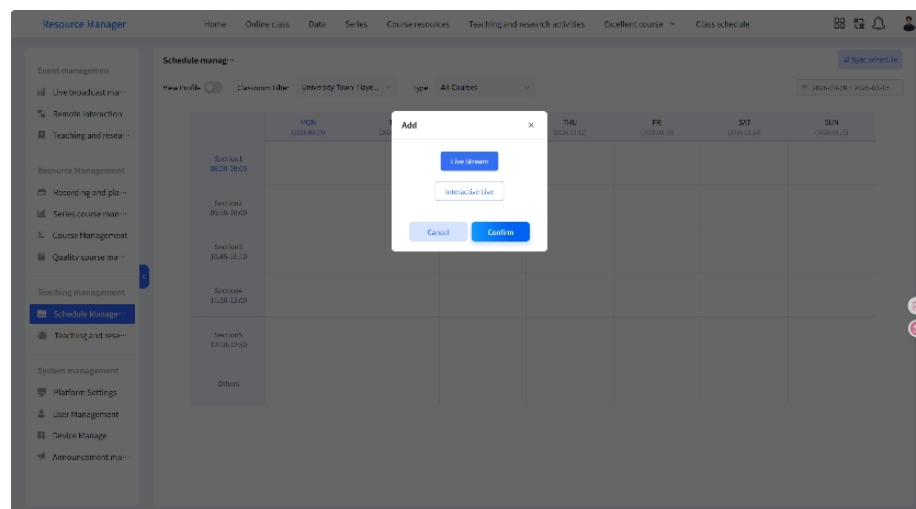
9.32 Schedule Management



After enabling the [View My] feature, you can only view your own courses in the schedule table.

The classroom filter allows you to view the schedule of a specific classroom. Use the "Course Type" filter to select live courses, remote courses, or regular courses. After selection, only courses of the corresponding type will be displayed.

Sync Schedule: After creating a schedule for a classroom, click "Sync Schedule" to view the created courses on the corresponding devices in that classroom.

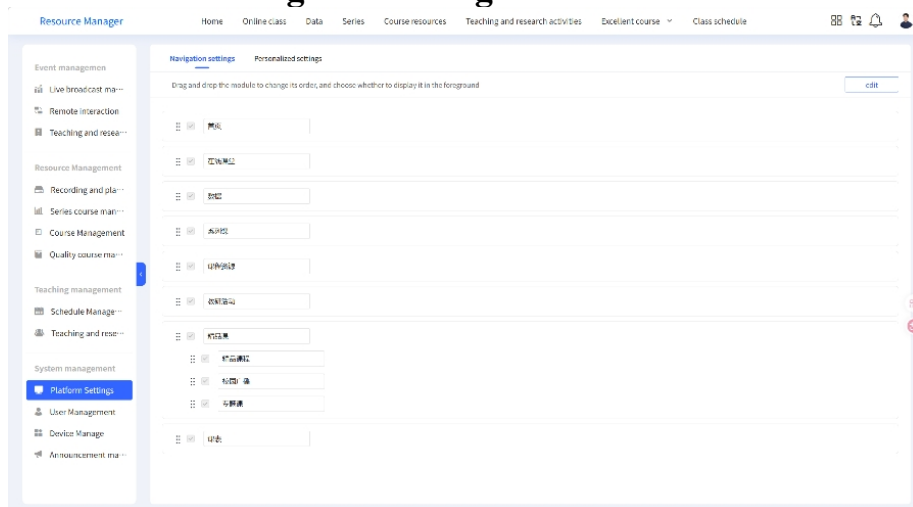


After selecting the target classroom, click the corresponding course time slot to see the [Add] button. Click [Add] to choose between adding a live stream or remote session. 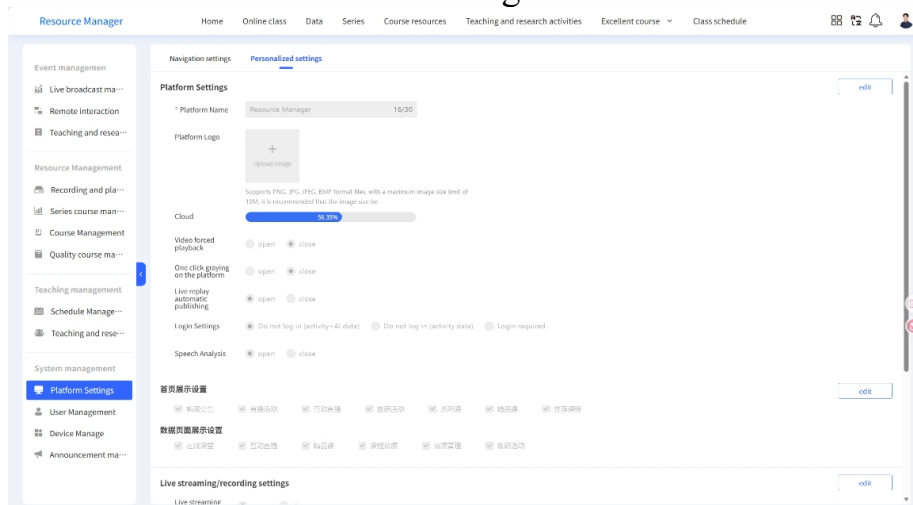

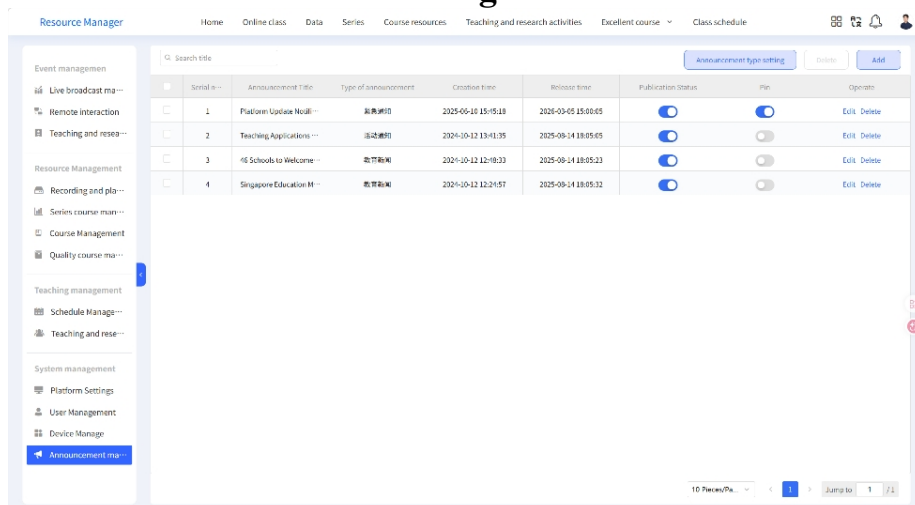

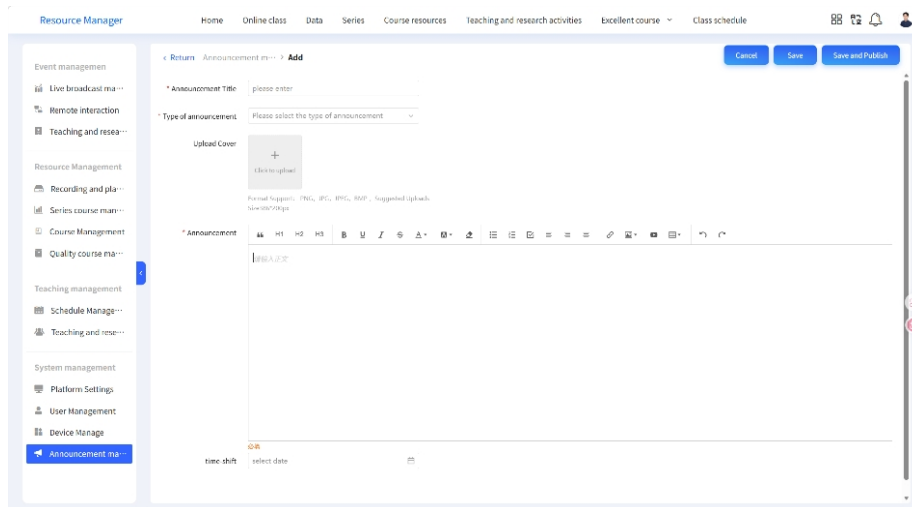
Enter the keyword of the announcement title in the search box to find related announcements.

9.44.2 Announcement Type Settings



Click [Announcement Type Settings] to go to the announcement type addition interface. Enter the name of the type you want to add in the type field, then click OK. The type will be added successfully. You can select this type when adding new announcements.

9.44.3 New Announcement



Click [Add] to go to the news announcement form. You can choose scheduled release. After completing the form, click [Save] to keep the announcement unpublished. To publish, tap the publish button in the status bar. Click [Save and Publish] to release the announcement immediately.

9.44.4 Edit the announcement





Published status indicates released announcements, while gray indicates unpublished ones.

Click [Edit] to modify the announcement.

Click [Delete] to remove this announcement.

After selecting multiple announcements, click [Delete] next to [Add] to delete them all at once.

When the [Pin] button is lit, the announcement is pinned.

When the button is gray, the announcement is not pinned.
