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1. Overview

Its core function is to enhance teaching efficiency and foster in-depth communication and collaboration among teachers, students, and peers. The following section details the usage of this seminar smart classroom system.

2. Function Introduction

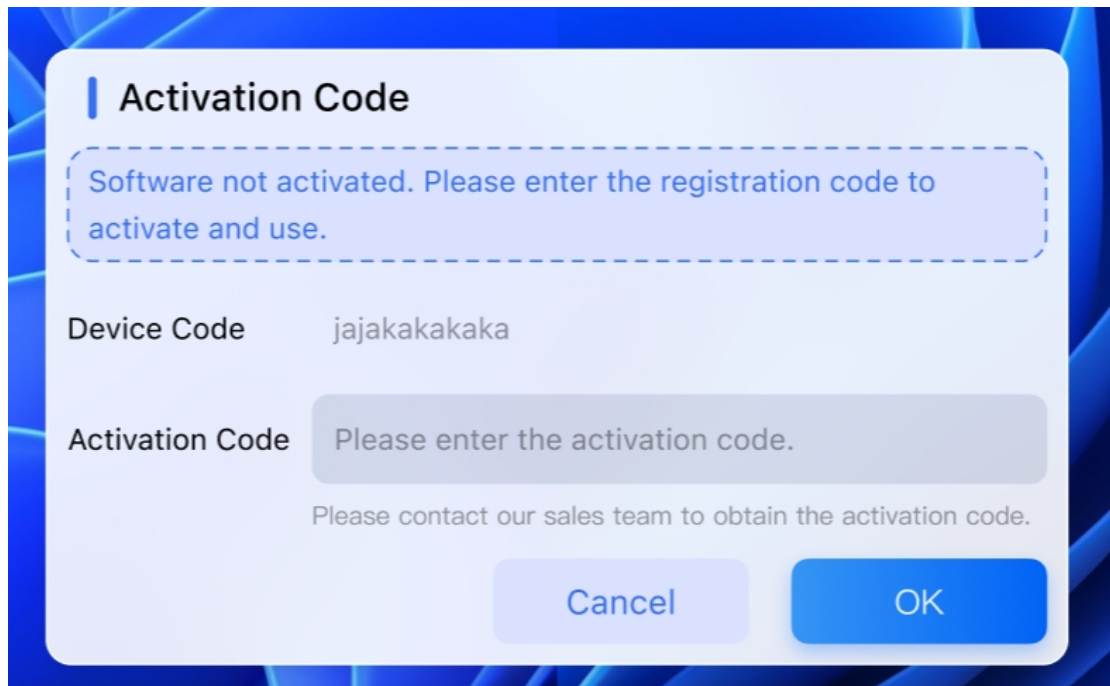
2.1 Configuration Environment

For the first time, you need to install and configure the seminar-style smart classroom system on the teaching host. The following section provides a step-by-step guide with images and text on how to install and activate the system on Windows.

2.1.1 Activation

Install the seminar smart classroom system on Windows. For optimal performance, we recommend using Windows 10 Flagship or later versions.

After installation, launch the app. An activation window will appear. Enter the activation code and click OK (the code is provided by the sales team). The app will be activated and ready for use.



2.1.2 Related Issues

To ensure smooth operation of the seminar-style smart classroom system, please note the following points:

- (1) Install the teacher and group software on your large-screen computer and group computers, respectively.
- (2) After installing the software, you need to activate it separately.
- (3) After installation, the group end must select the teacher end's IP address to connect
- (4) Supports up to 1 (teacher) + 8 (group) for interaction

2.2 Teacher End

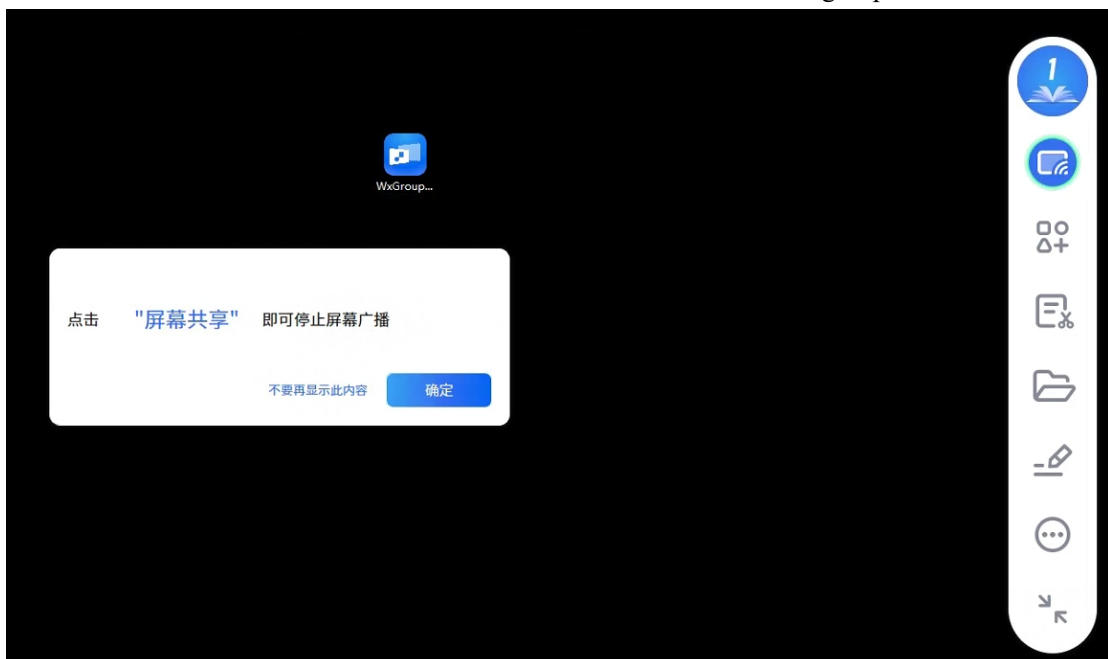
2.2.1 Toolbar

After launching the application, the right side of the desktop displays the toolbar, which includes screen broadcasting, interactive tools, screenshot questions, files, and comments. The top displays the number of currently online groups.



2.2.2 Screen Broadcast

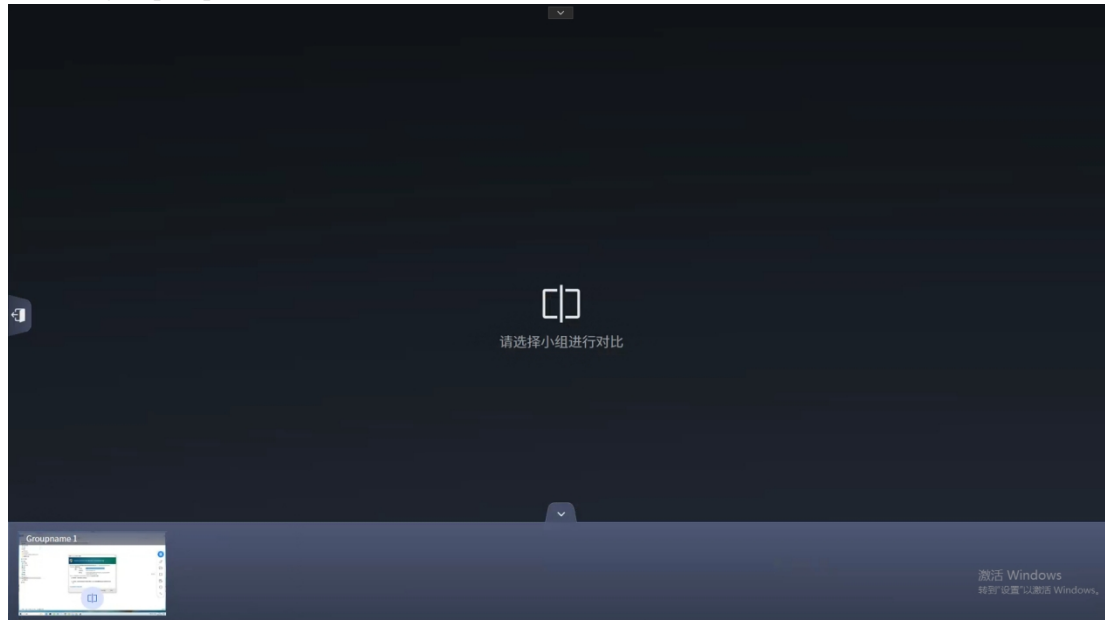
Screen broadcast: Click to broadcast the classroom screen content to the group



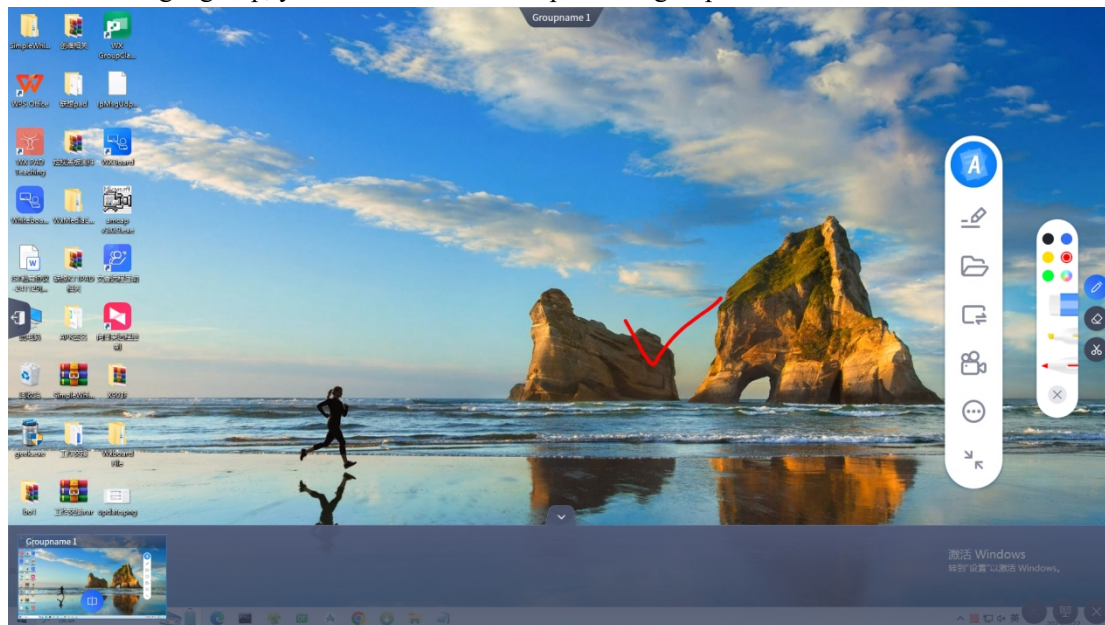
2.2.3 Interactive Tools

2.2.3.1 Demonstration Comparison

Click to enable presentation comparison. The group screen is displayed on the teacher's end.
Select a group to present.

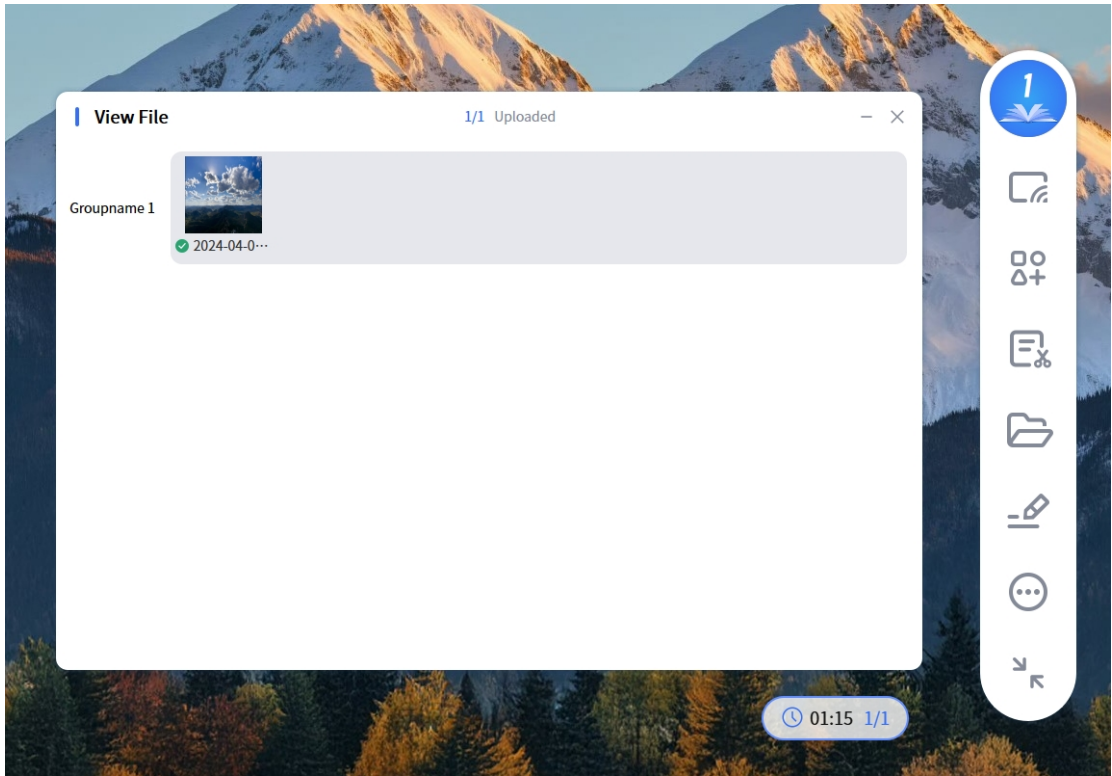


After selecting a group, you can annotate and explain the group screen



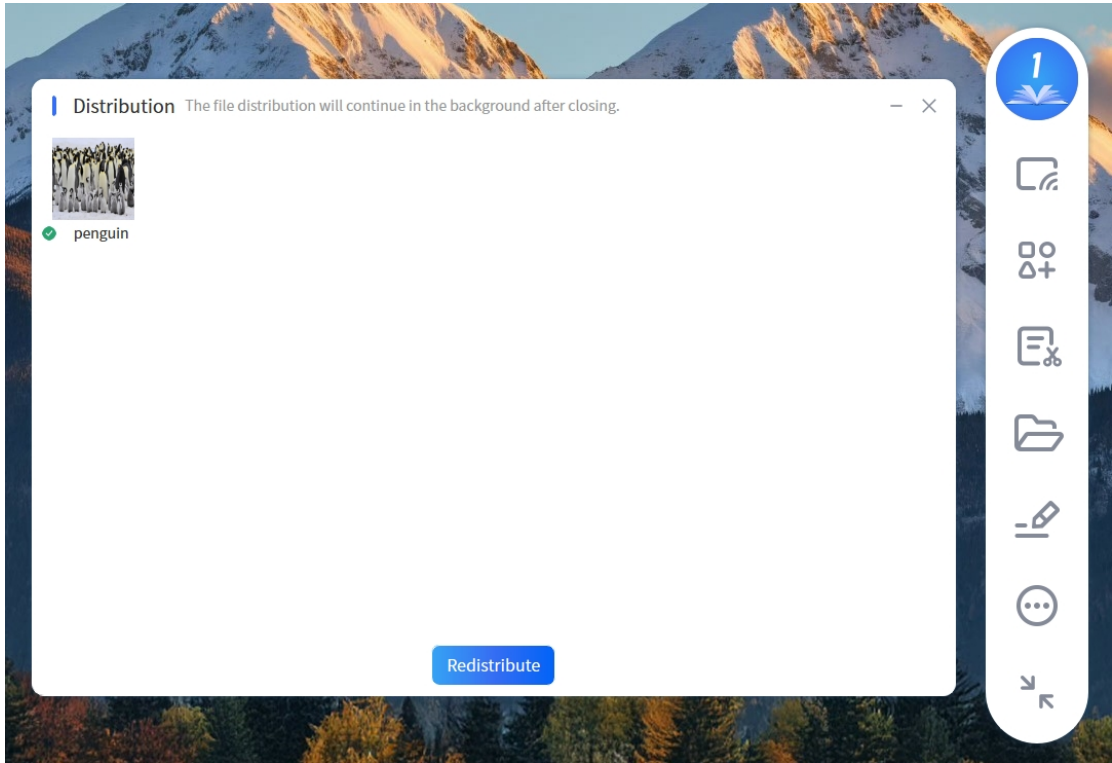
2.2.3.2 File Upload

Click to upload files. The group can upload files to the teacher and view the number and content of the files.



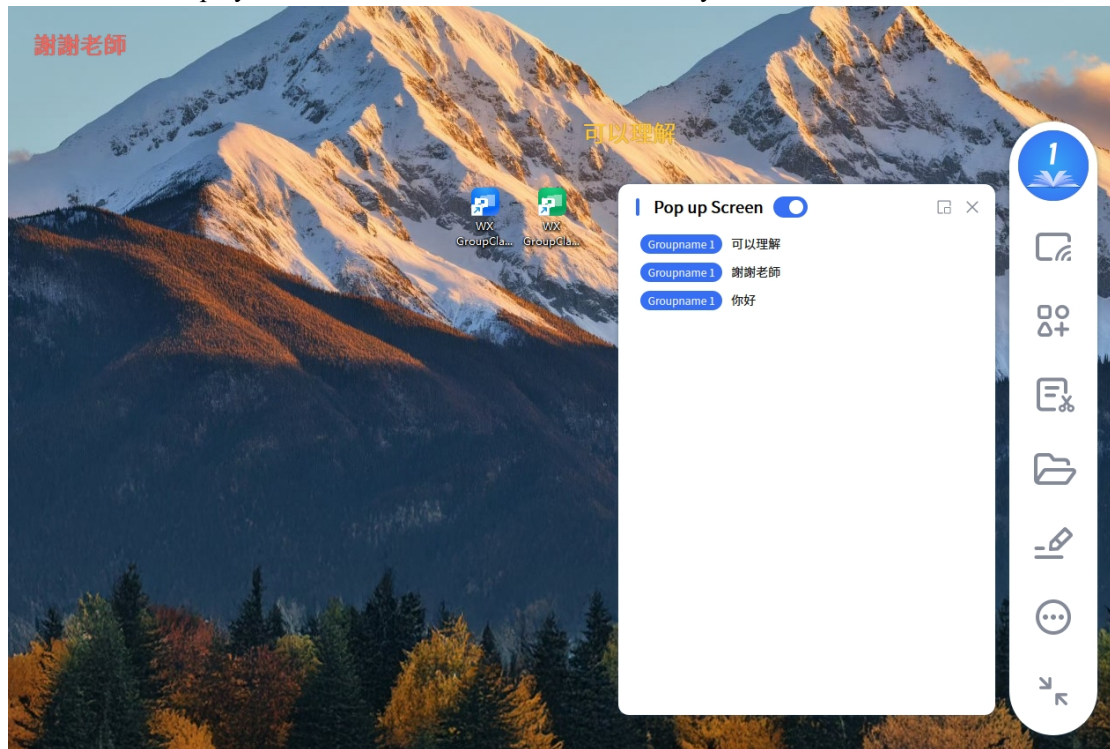
2.2.3.3 Data Distribution

Click on file distribution to select a local file and send it to the group



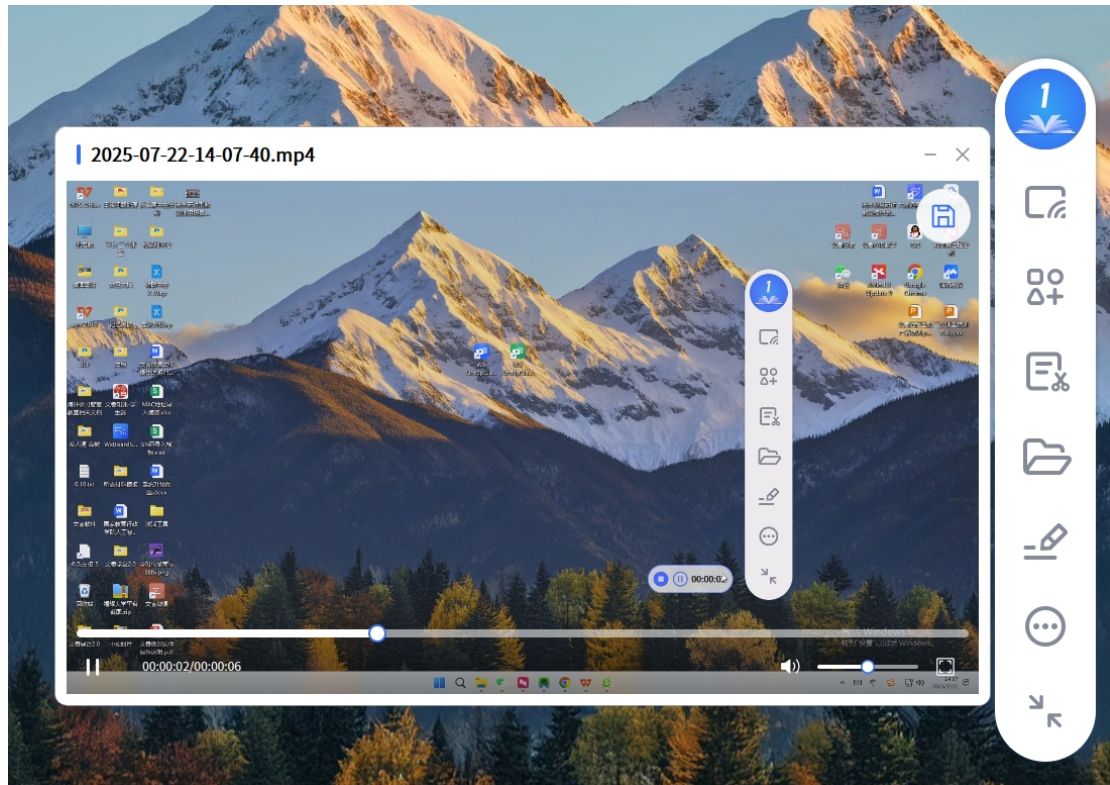
2.2.3.4 Bullet Comments

Click to enable bullet comments. The group can edit and send bullet comments to the teacher, who can choose to display them in the screen or in the window only.



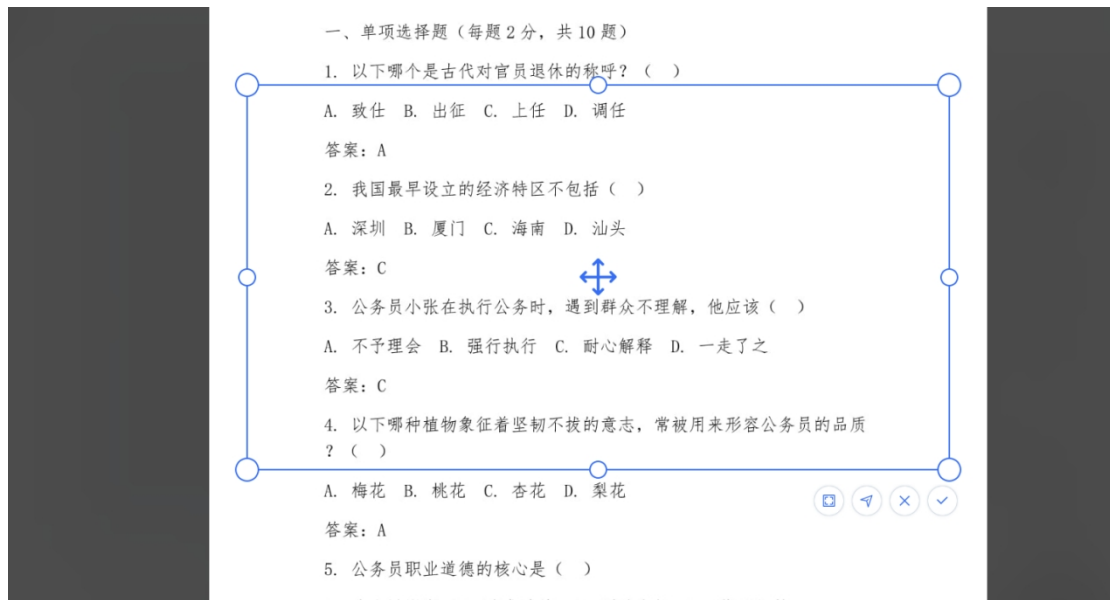
2.2.3.5 Screen Recording

After clicking Record Screen, a countdown will display, and the screen content will be recorded. You can save the recording to your local device.



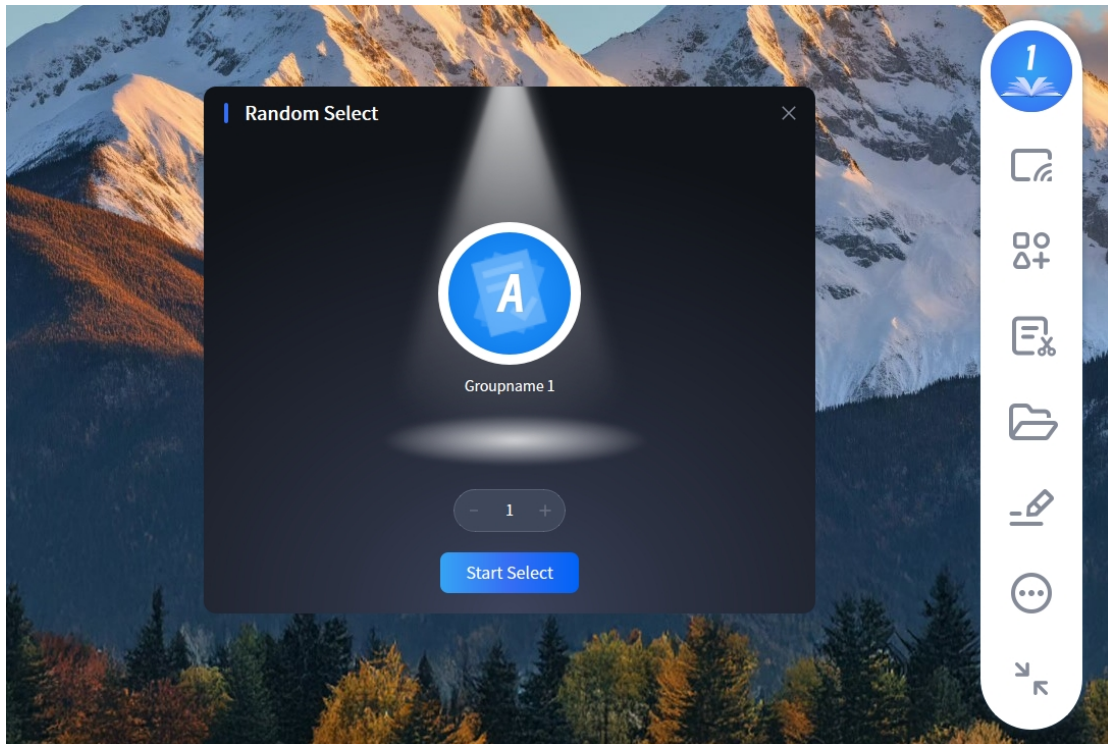
2.2.3.6 Screenshots

Click the screenshot to capture the current screen content. You can adjust the screenshot area size and view comments in full screen. Click the send button to send the screenshot directly to the group.



2.2.3.7 Random Selection

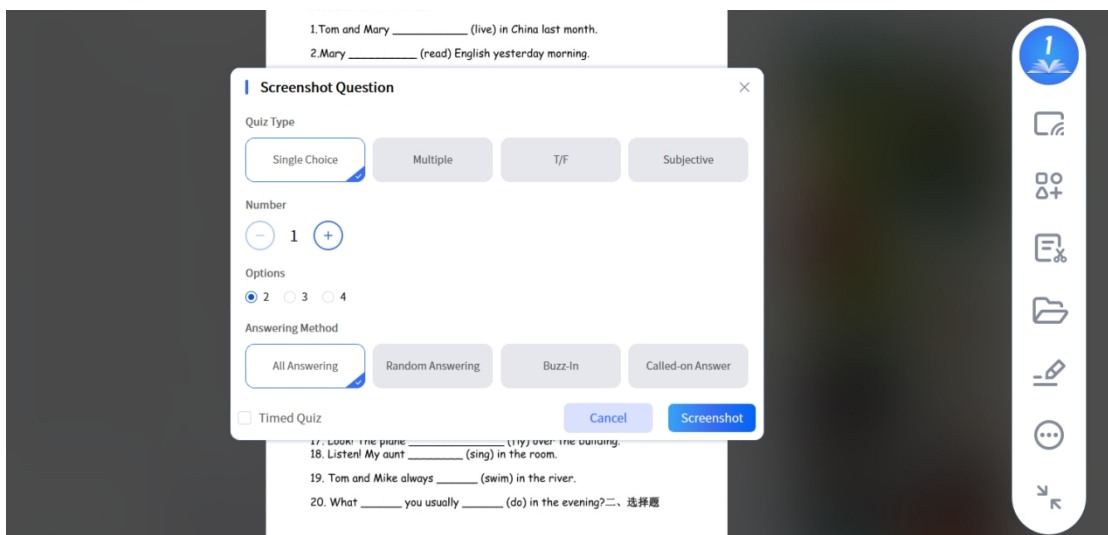
Click Random Selection to choose an online group. After selection, you can evaluate the group.

2.2.4.1 Question Design

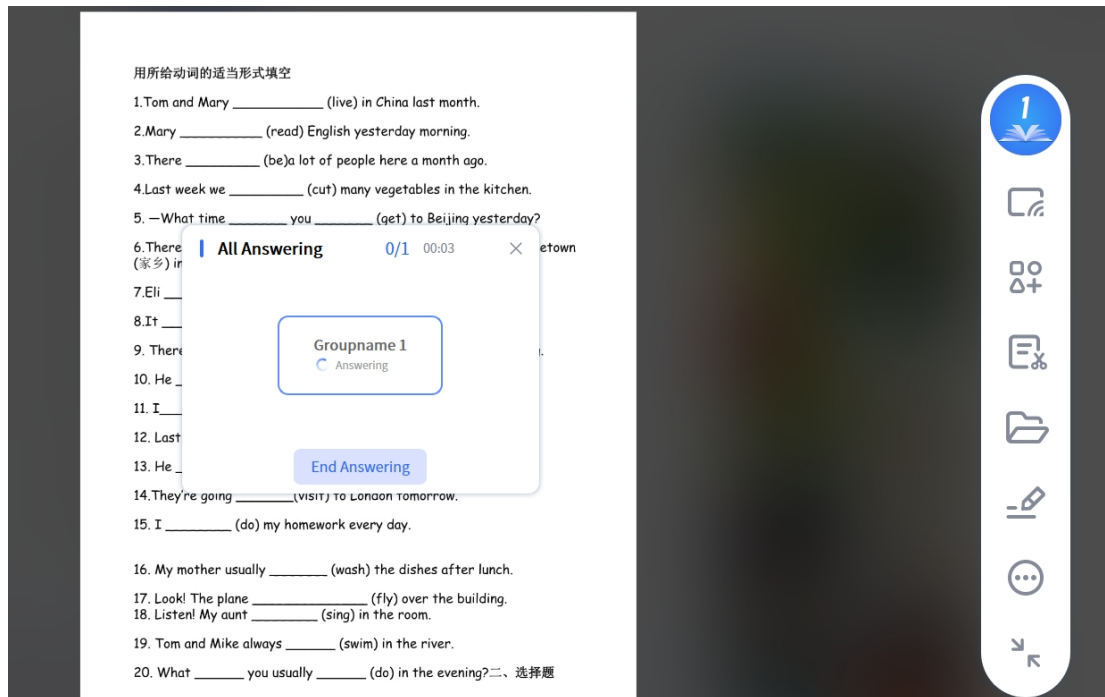
Click the screenshot to set question type, number of questions, number of options, and answering method



2.2.4.2 Issue questions

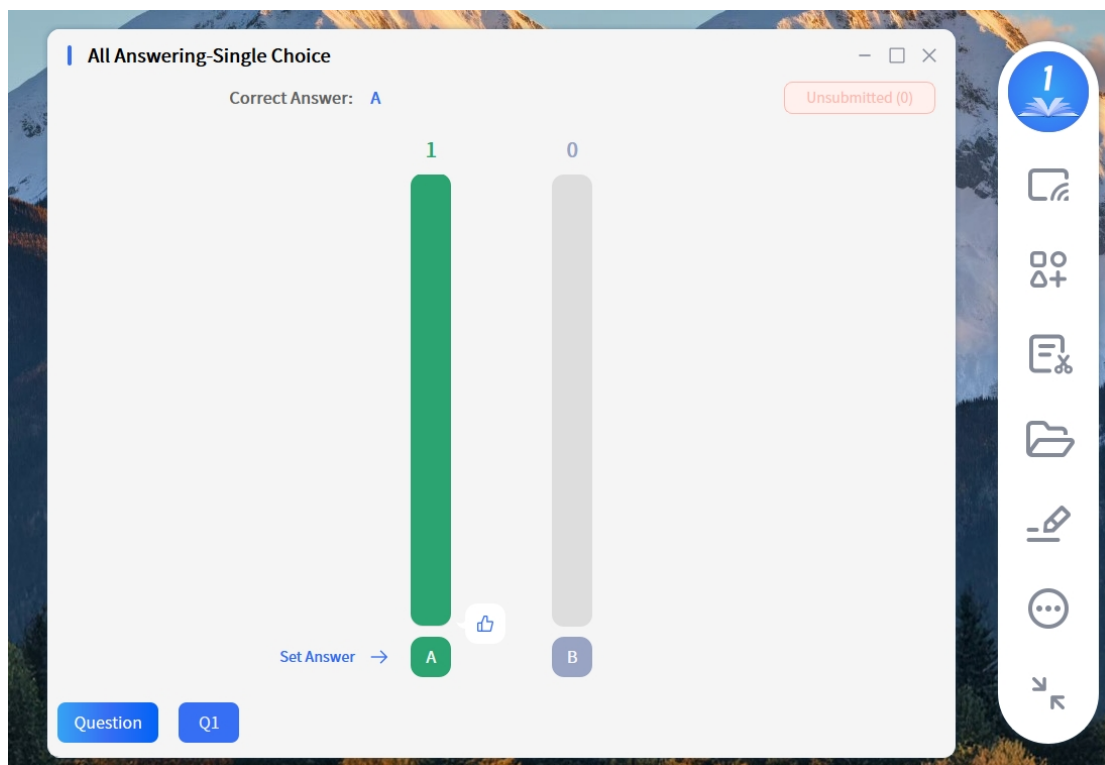
After taking a screenshot, the question is sent to the group. The group then answers based on the

question settings. The teacher can view the group's answers.



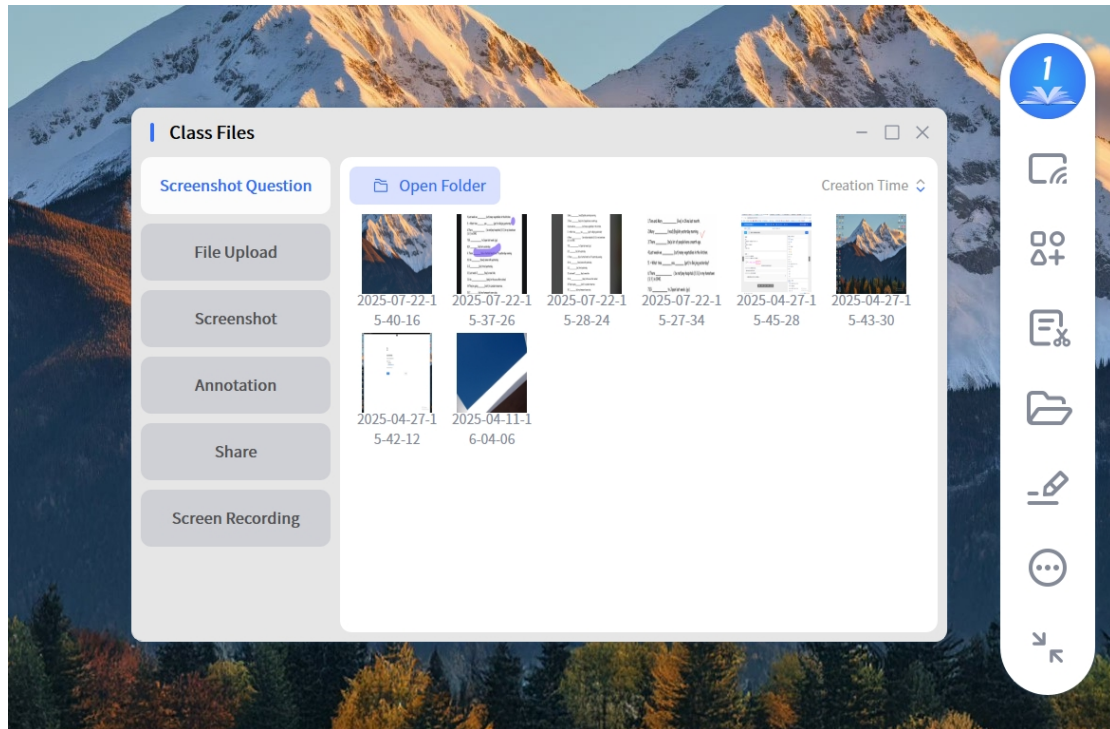
2.2.4.3 View Results

After completing the quiz, you can view the results. You can set correct answers and check group responses.



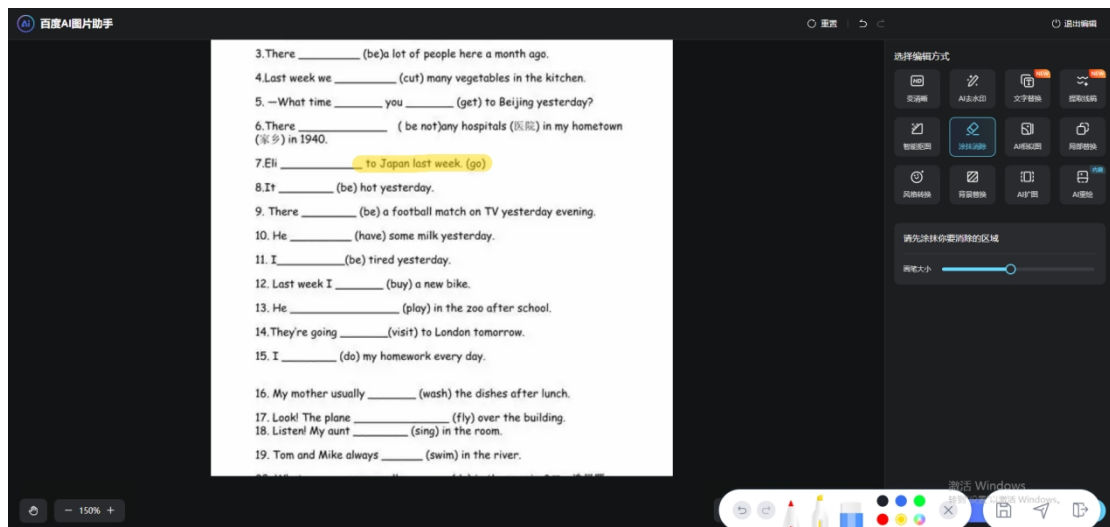
2.2.5 Documents

2.2.7.2 Settings

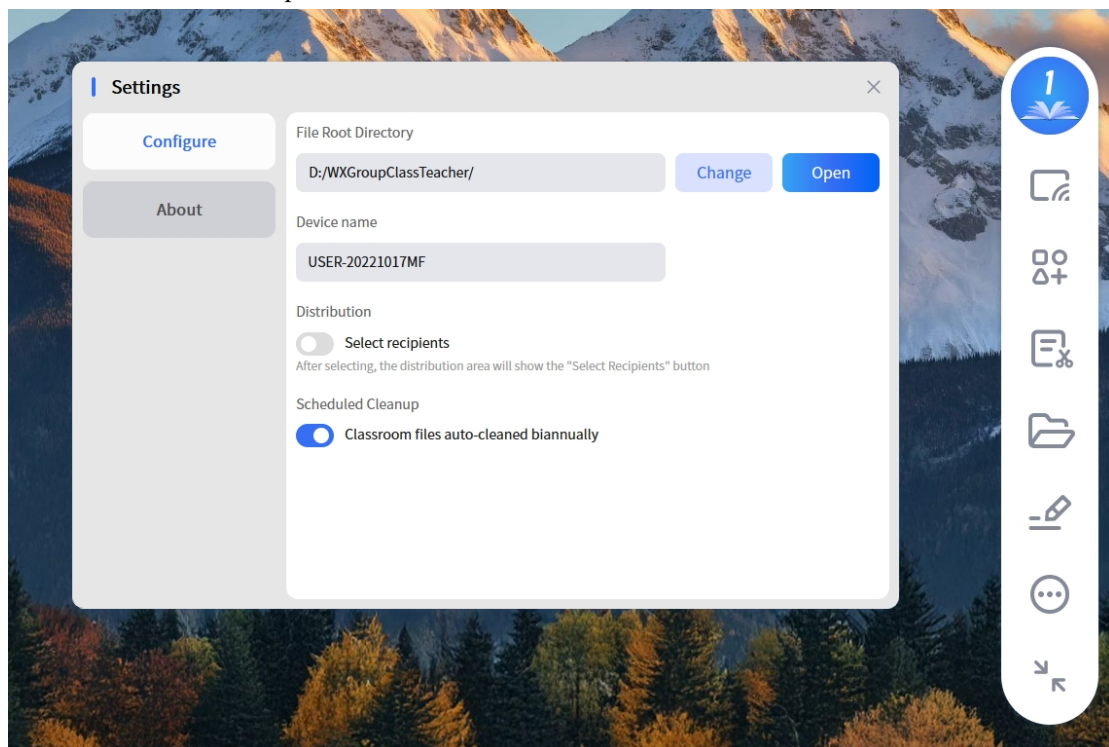
Click to set pop-up window

Enable scheduled cleanup



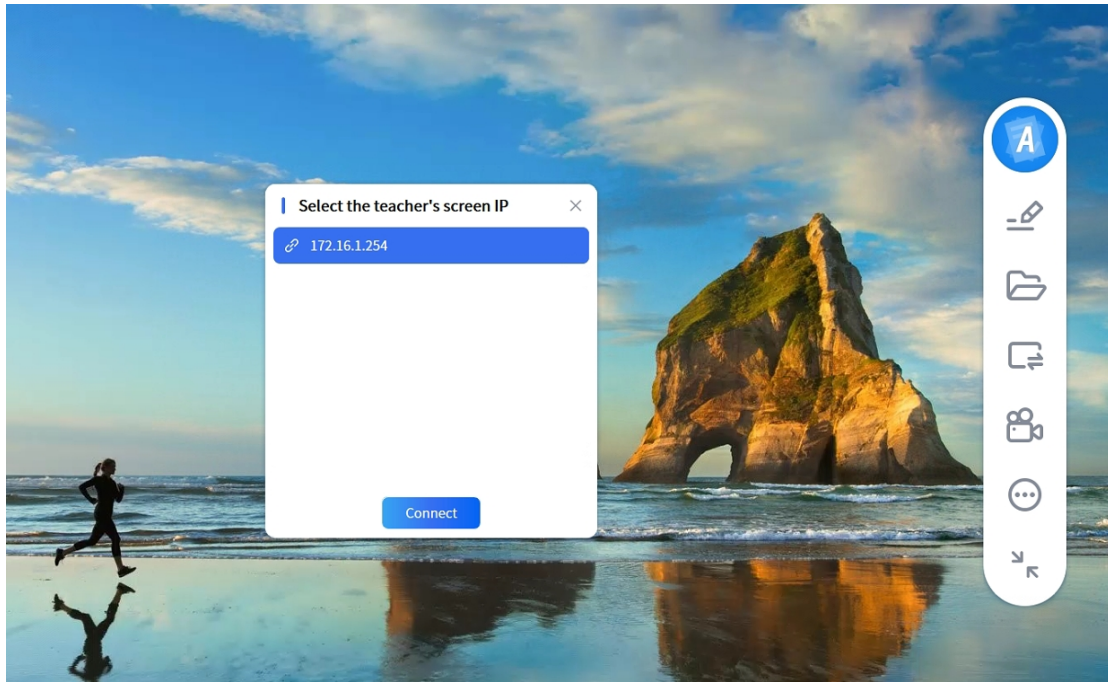
2.2.7.3 Regarding

2.3 Group End

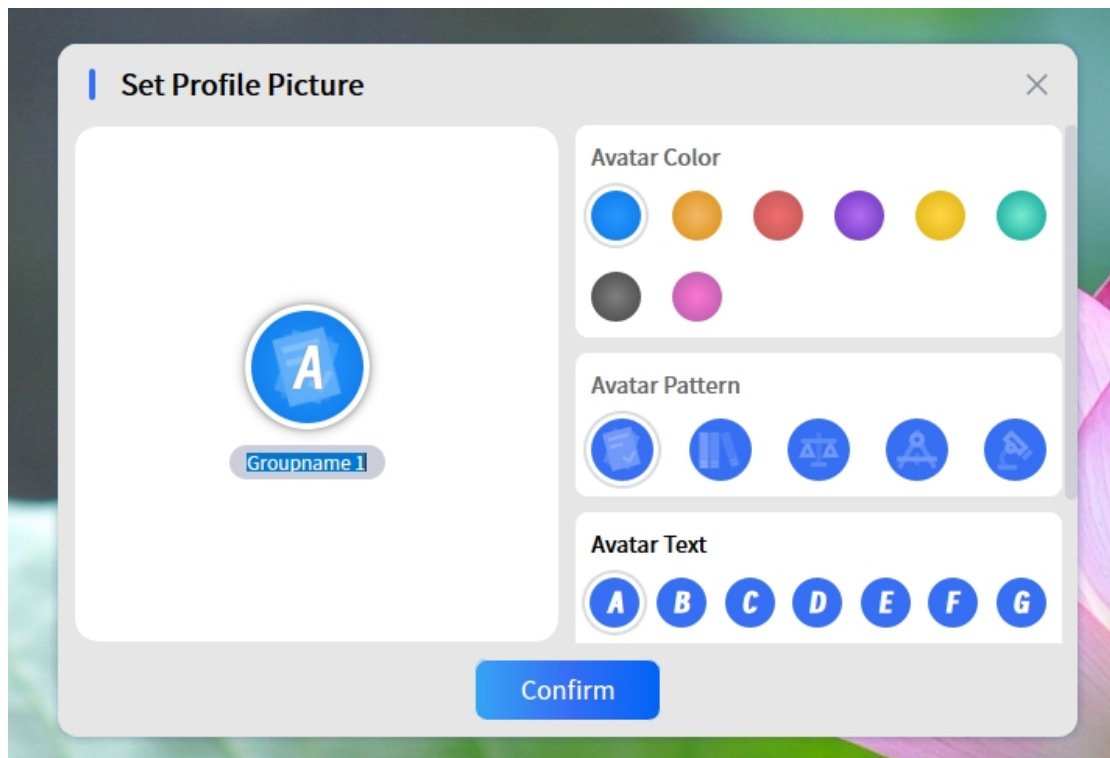
2.3.1 linkage

Enable the app to automatically pop up a window. Click the IP address to connect to the teacher's device.



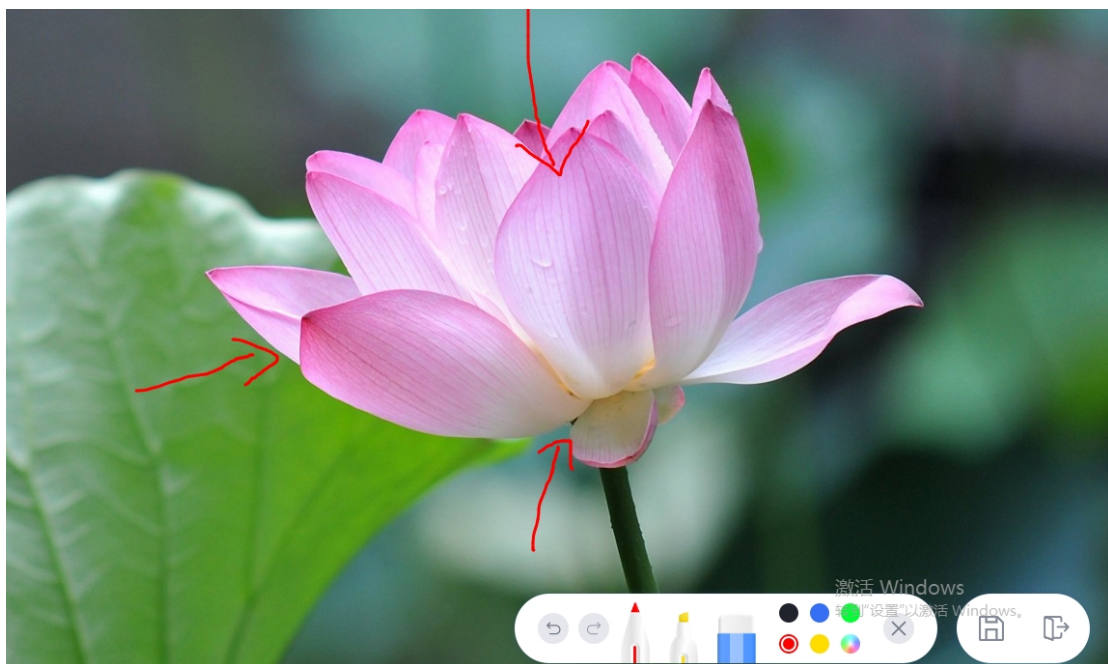
2.3.2 Group Information

Click the icon to open the pop-up window and modify group information



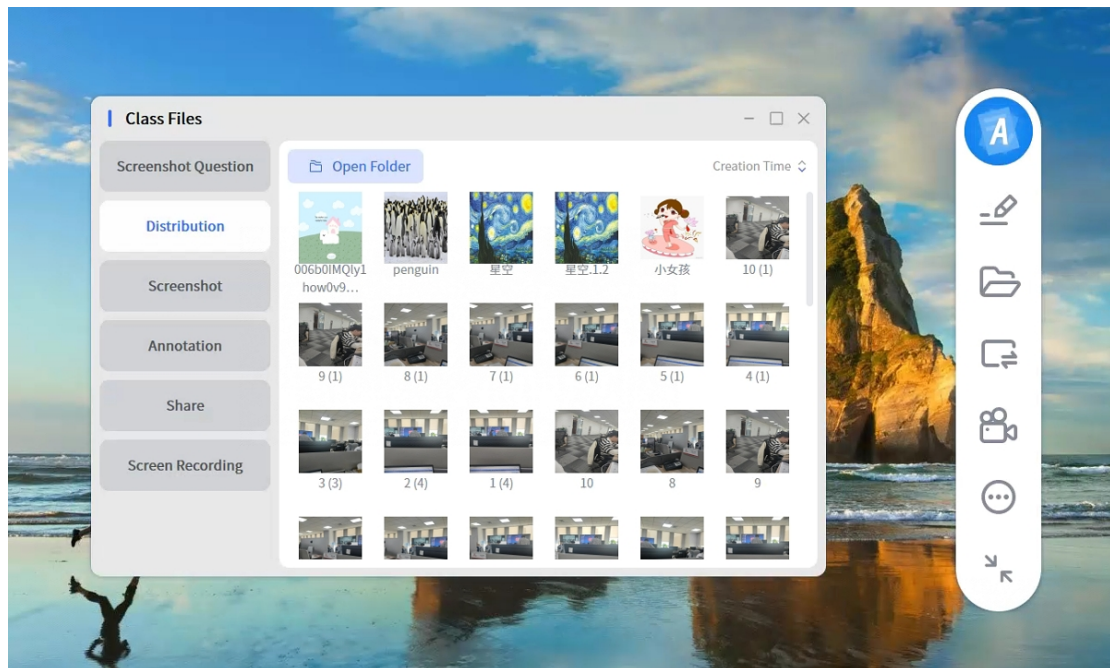
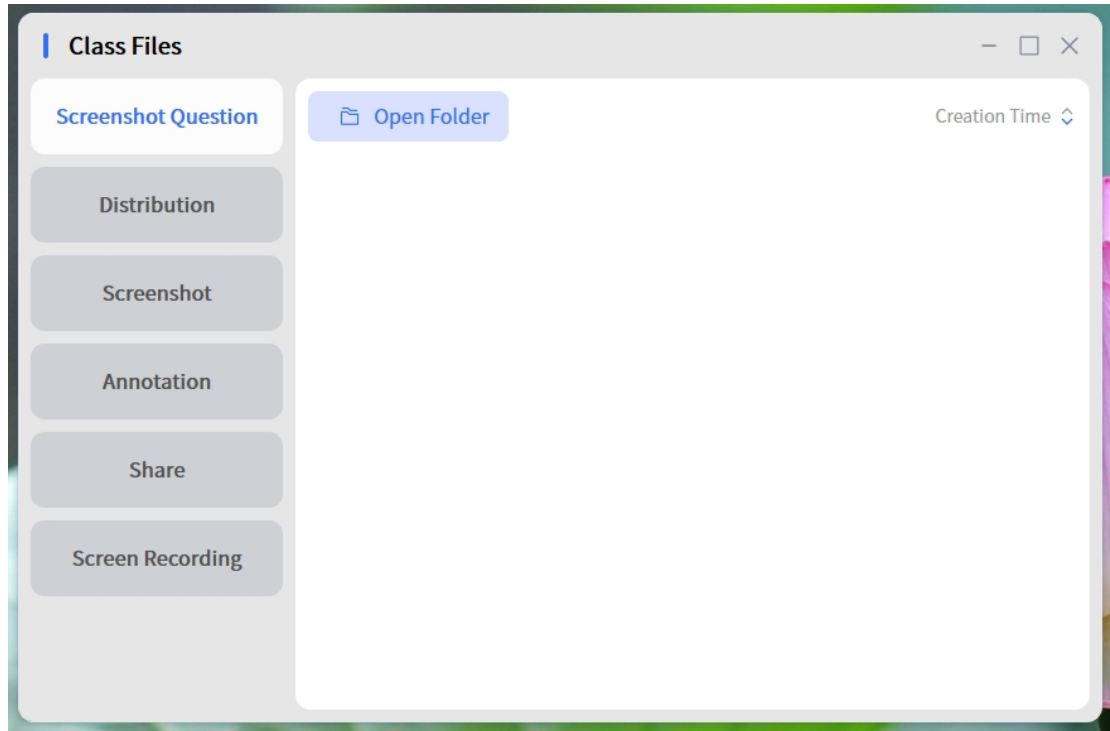
2.3.3 Comments

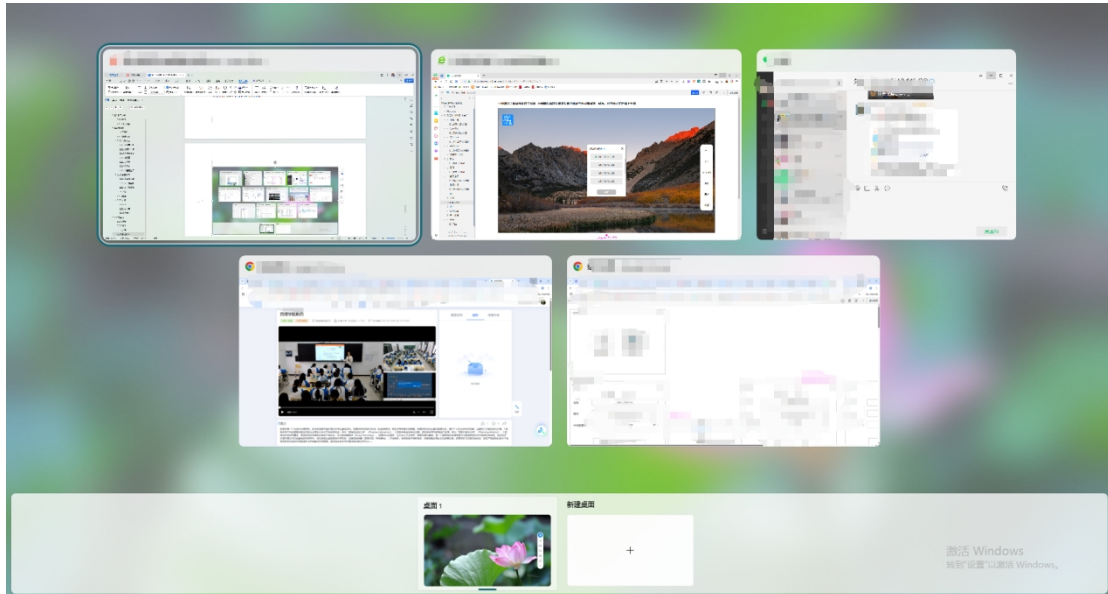
Teachers can view materials, comments, and screen recordings categorized in the



file.

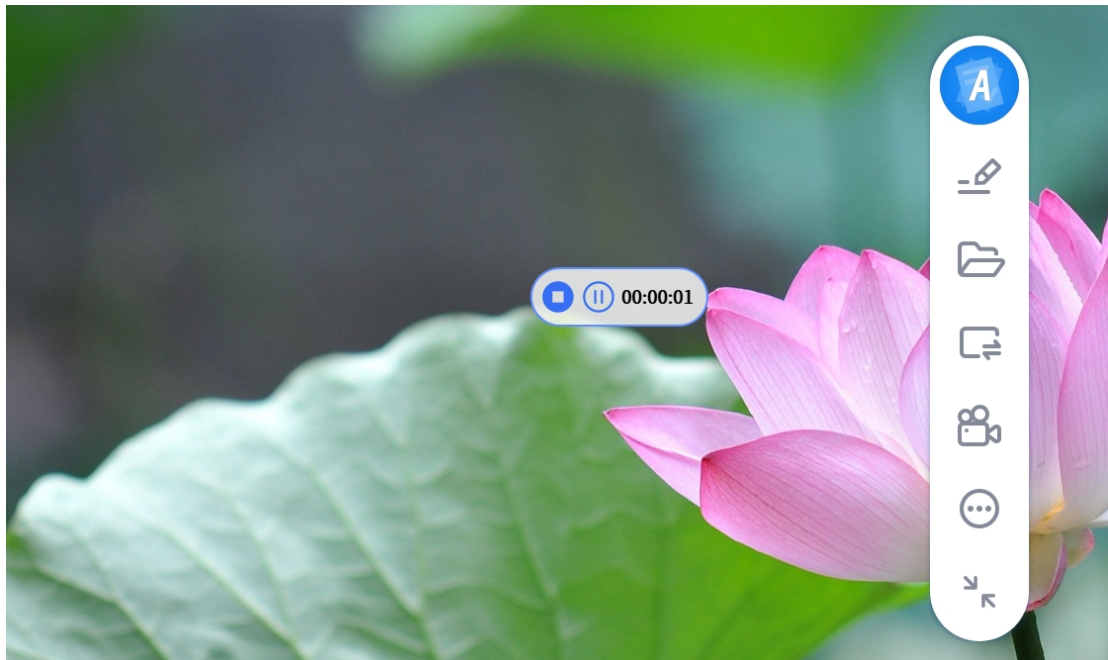
2.3.5 Window Switching

2.3.6 Screen Recording

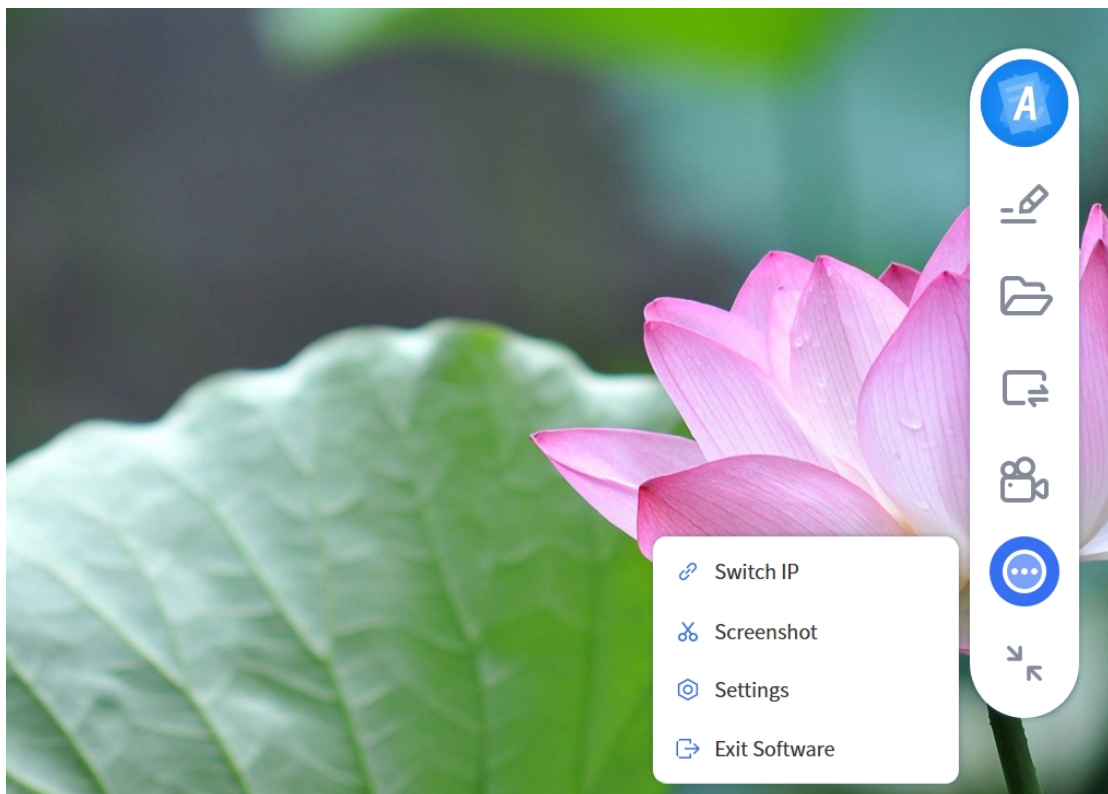
After clicking Record Screen, a countdown will display, and the screen content will be recorded. You can save the recording to your local device.

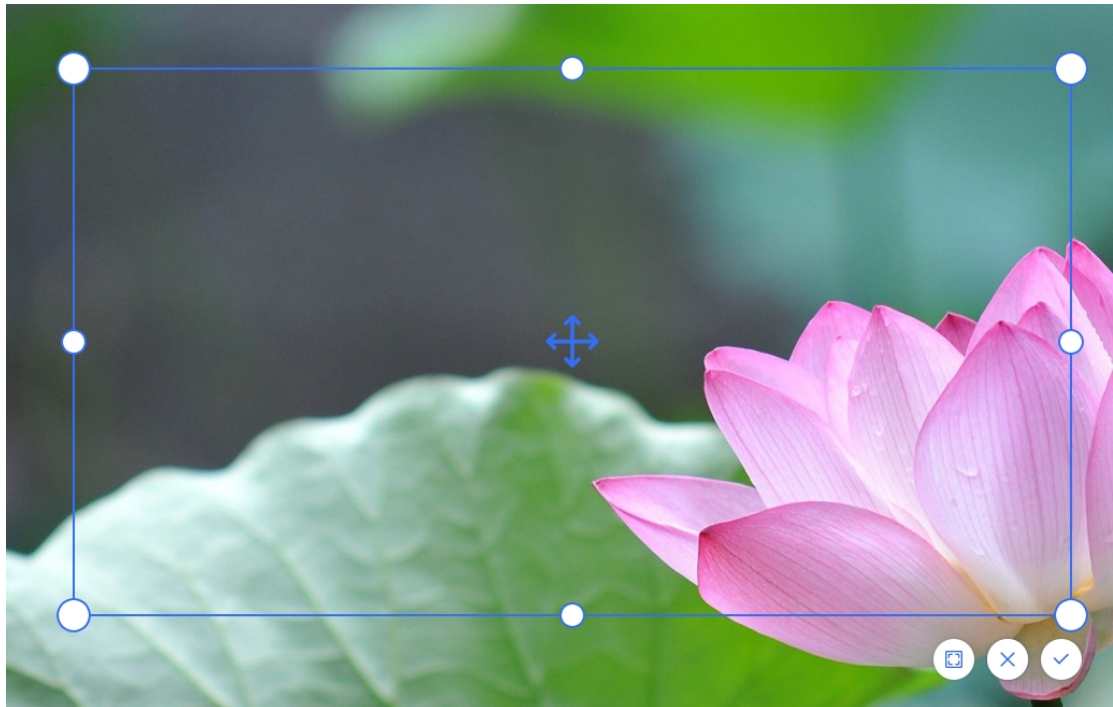

Click to capture the screen



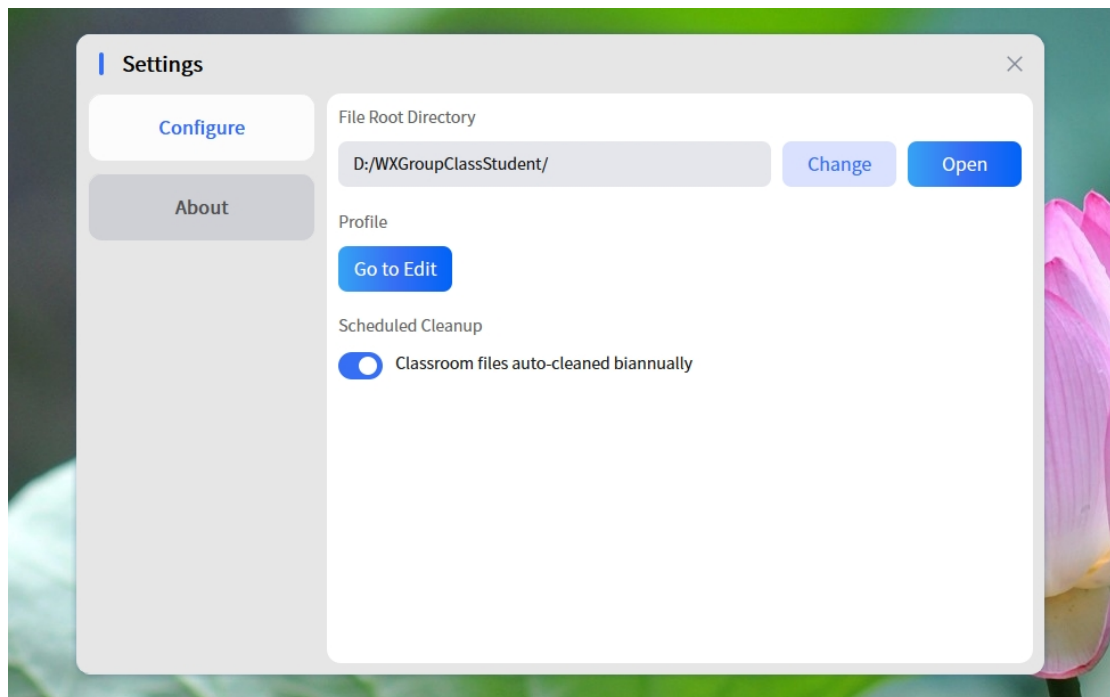

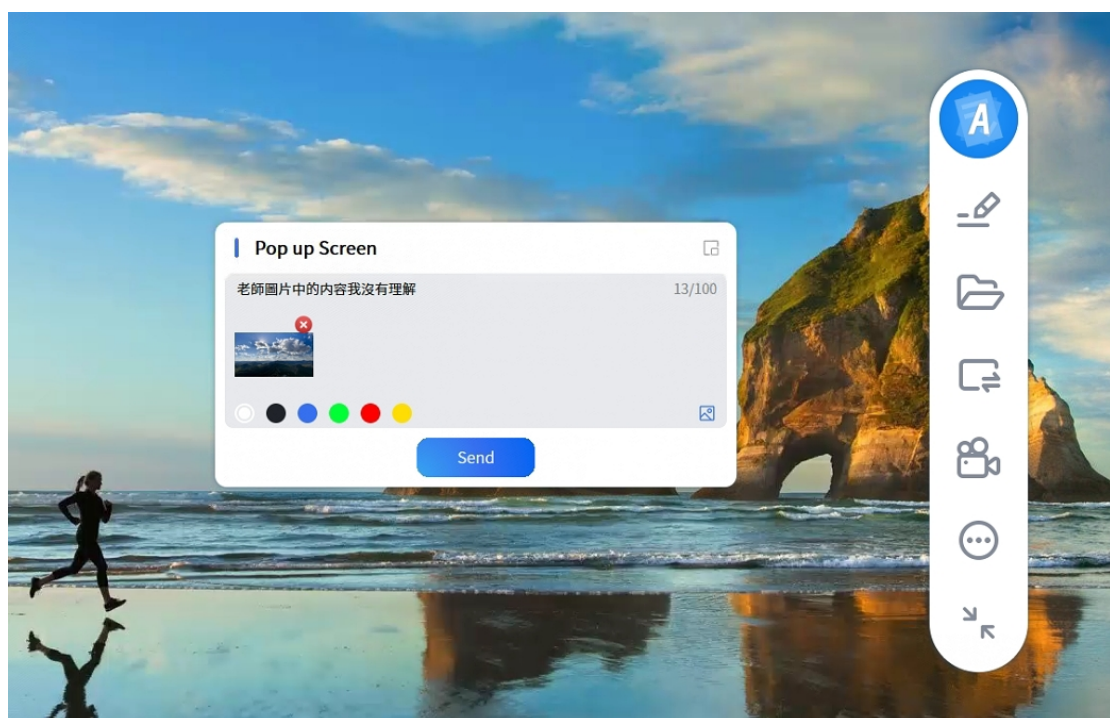

2.3.8 Group Interaction

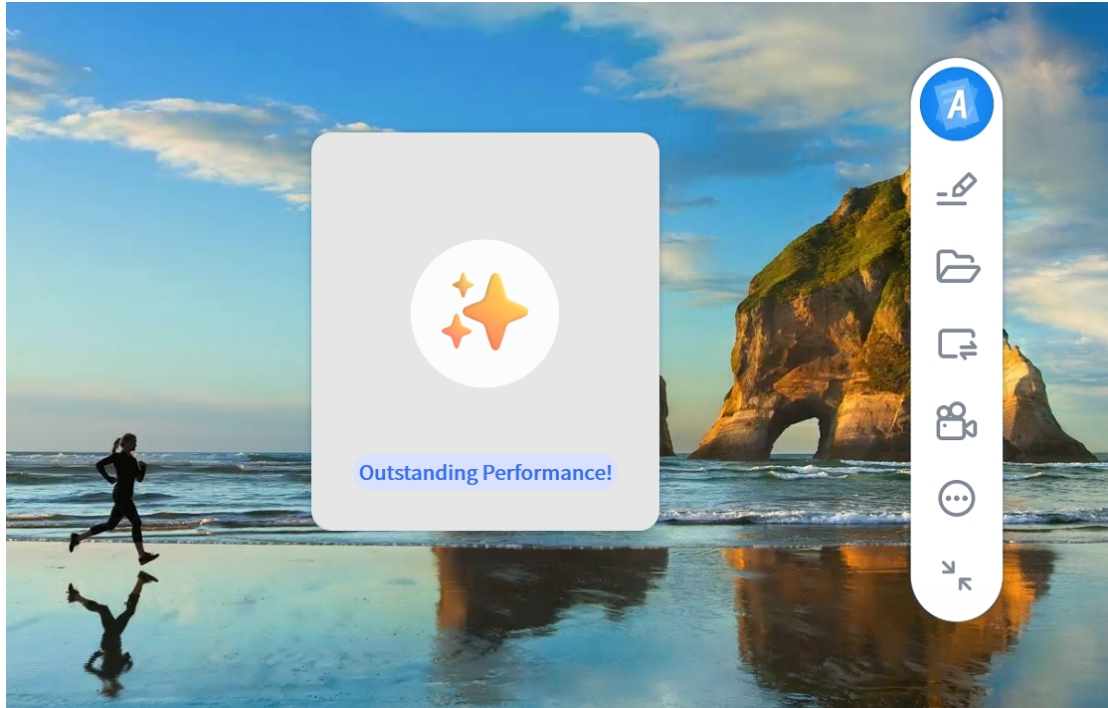
2.3.8.1 Bullet Comments
