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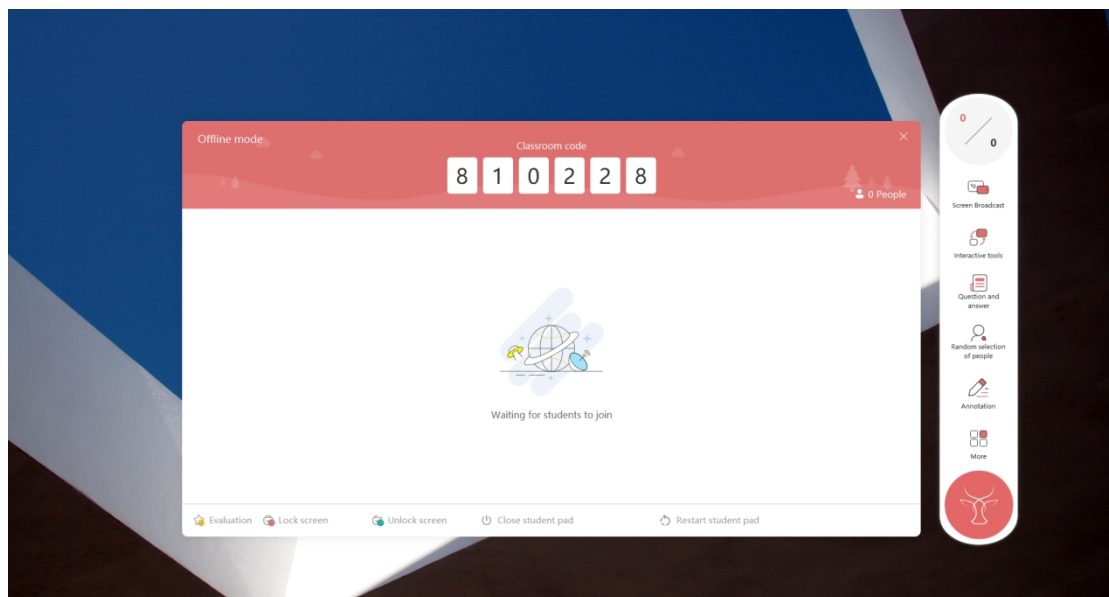
Part 1 Overview

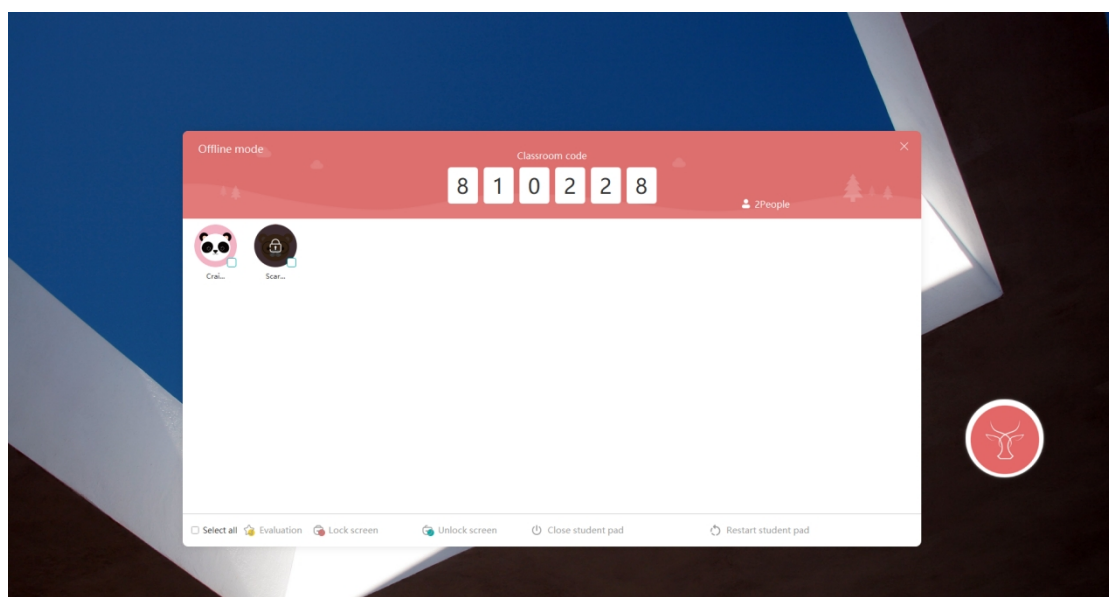
Part 2: Function Introduction

Display the class code. Enter the code to join the class.

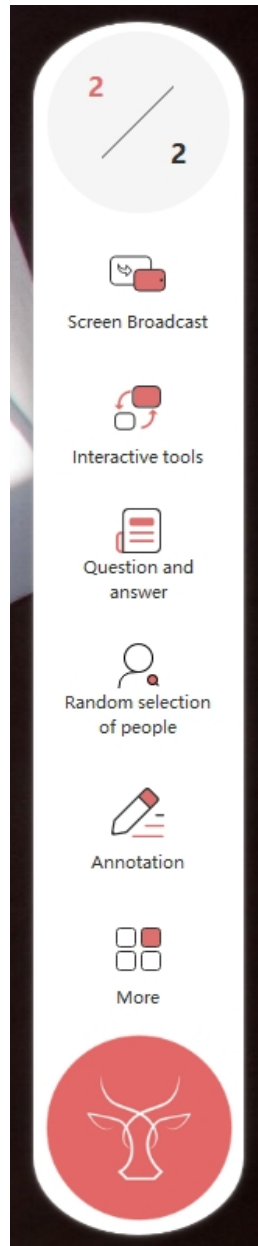


Display student information and status who joined the class



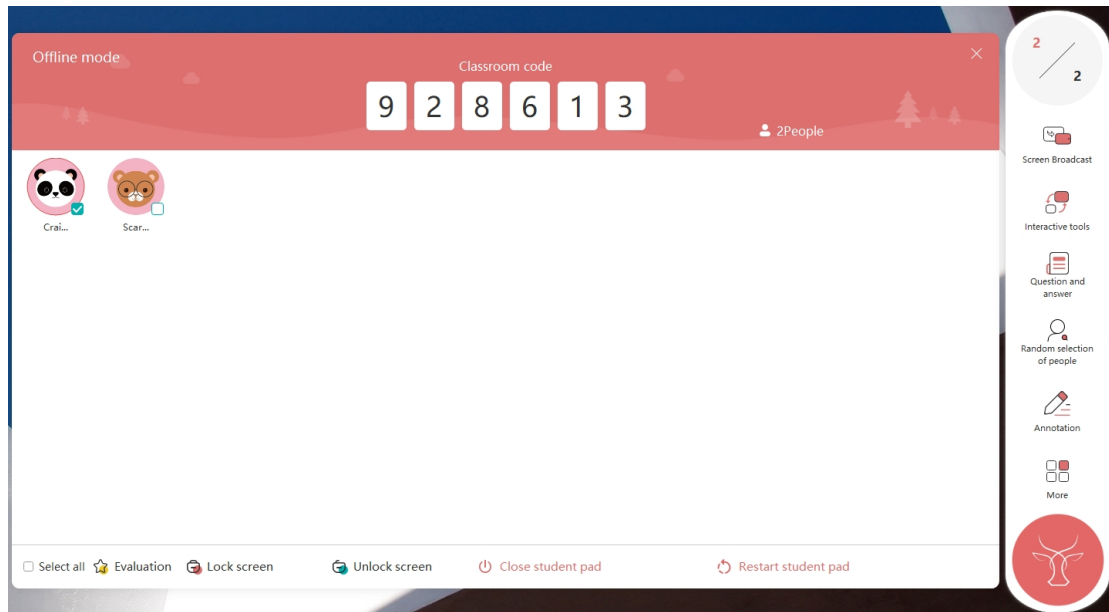
2.2 Toolbar

After entering the class, the toolbar appears on the right side of the screen. You can drag it to expand or collapse.



2.2.1 Student List

Display the current list of online students. You can select students in the list to evaluate them, lock or unlock their PAD devices, and close the student's PAD with one click.



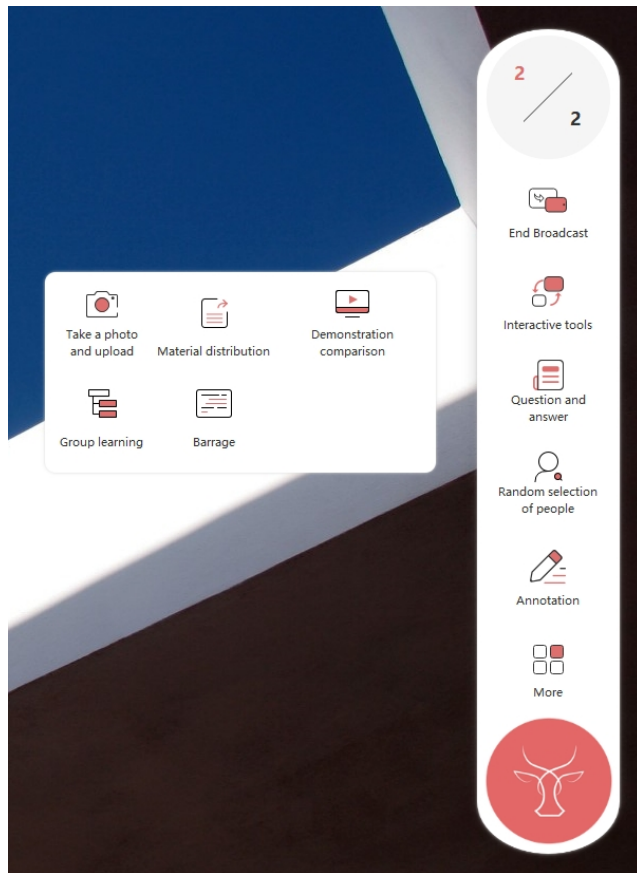
2.2.2 Screen Broadcast

You can enable screen broadcasting to project the large-screen image to the student's PAD. After enabling broadcasting, the toolbar will change to End Broadcast. Click to end screen broadcasting.



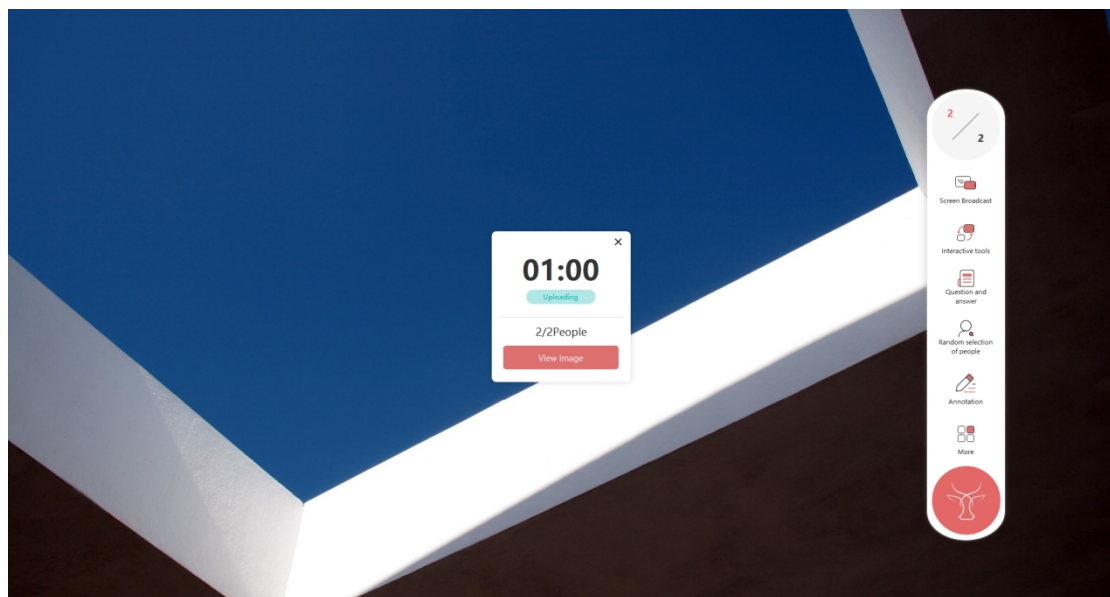
2.2.3 Interactive Tools

Click the interactive tools to choose from options like photo upload, material distribution, presentation comparison, group learning, and bullet comments for classroom interaction.

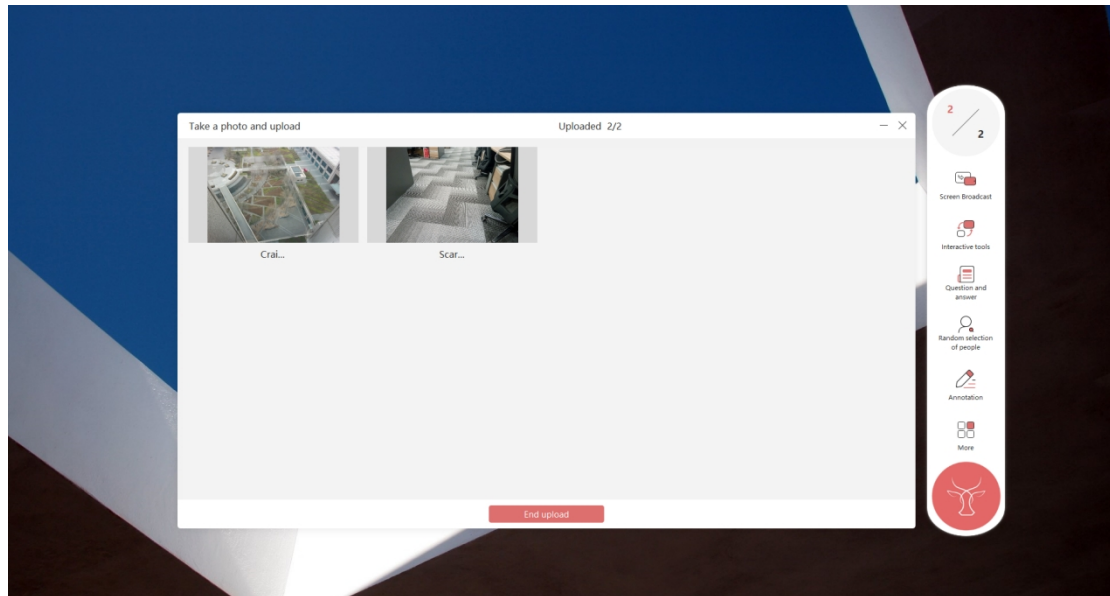


2.2.3.1 Photo Upload

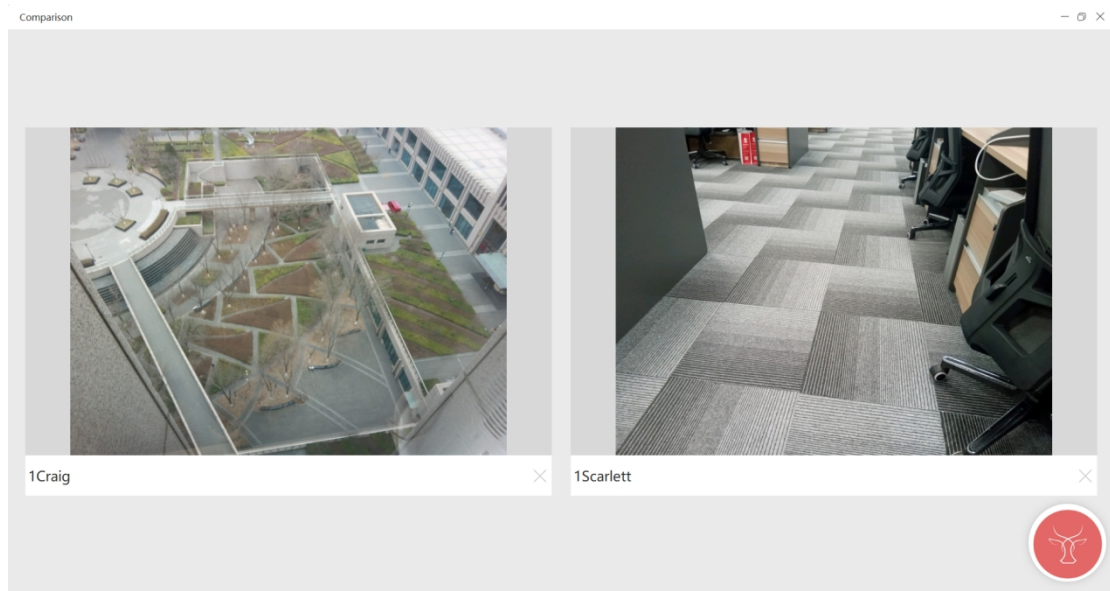
When enabled, students can use the PAD to take photos and upload them to the large screen. They can view the uploaded photos during the upload process and click the close button in the upper right corner to end the photo upload function.



Students can upload multiple images. The content and photo count will sync on the large screen after uploading. Click an image to preview.

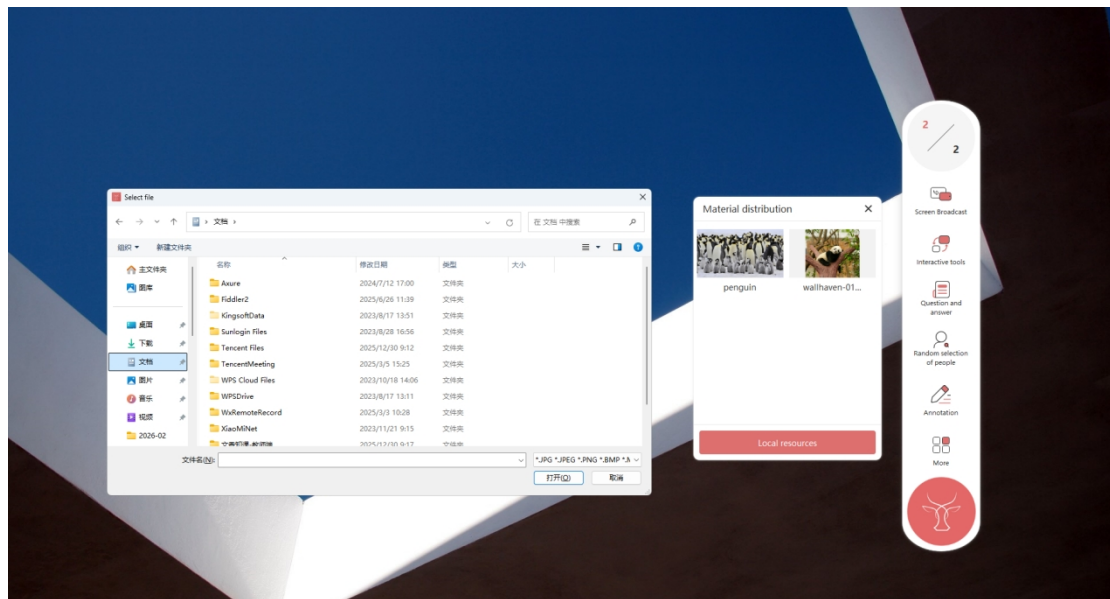


Compare images on the same screen after uploading



2.2.3.2 Data Distribution

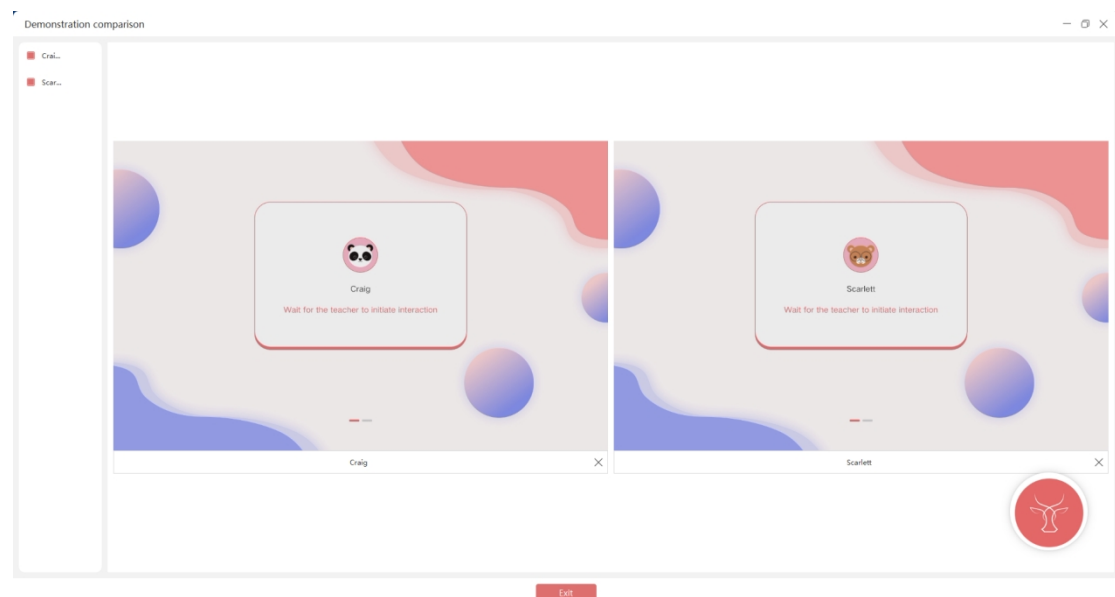
You can choose local or teaching resources. The file content will be displayed



on the large screen after sending.

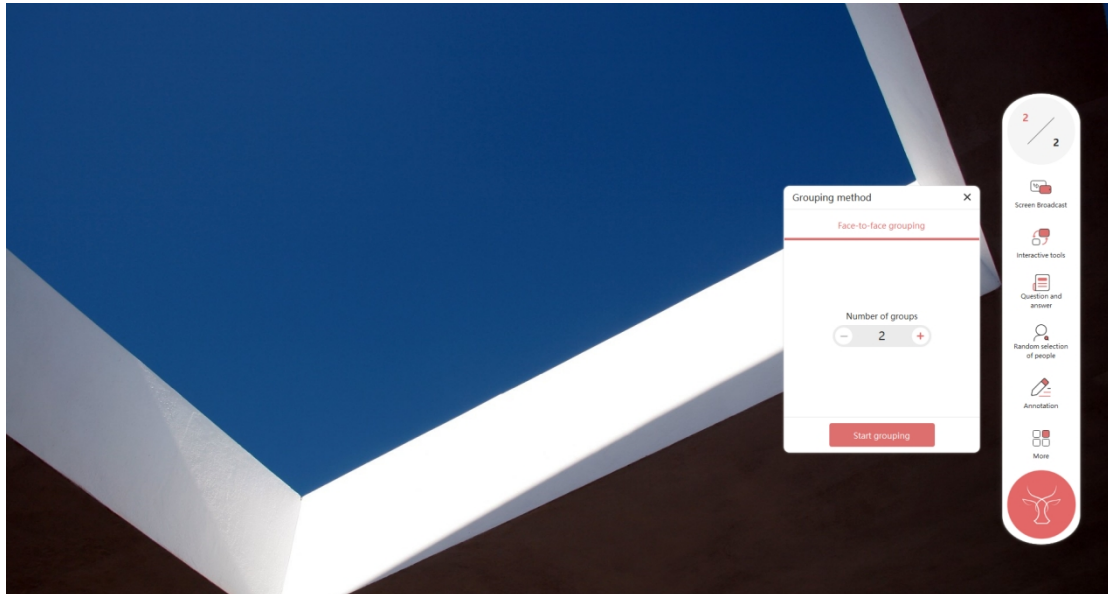
2.2.3.3 Demonstration Comparison

Select the student PAD screen to demonstrate and compare operations on the large screen, displaying the student device page content in real time.

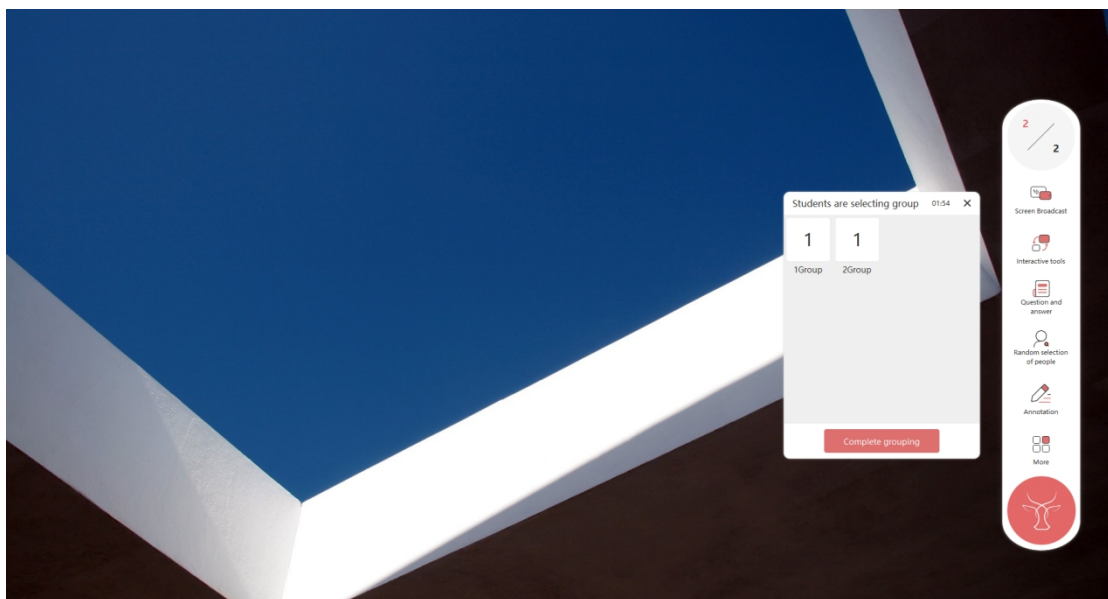


2.2.3.4 Group Learning

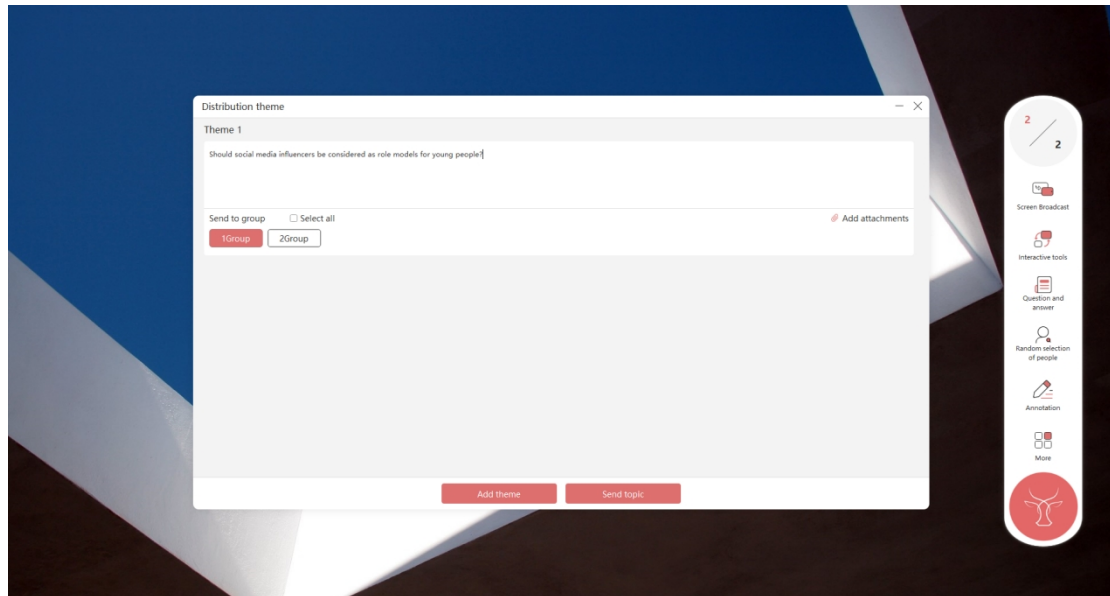
Divide students into multiple groups for face-to-face learning activities. Display the number of groups. Click the + or - icon to adjust the number of groups.



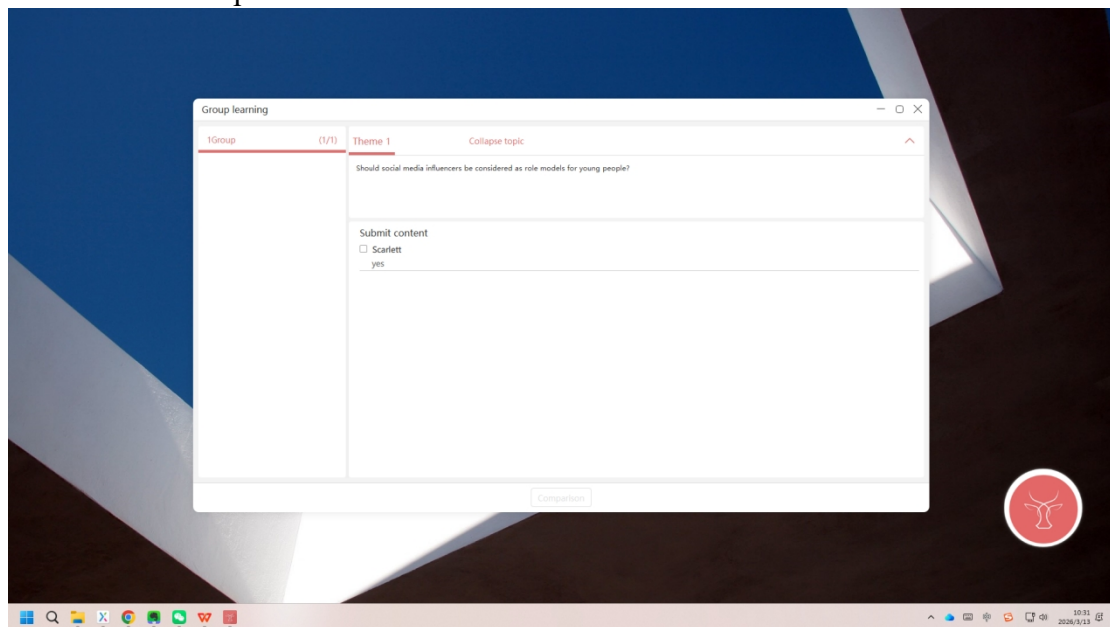
After grouping, click the topic distribution button to discuss and learn the group topics.



The group study discussion page displays submissions from group members. Click the stop discussion button at the bottom to end the discussion.

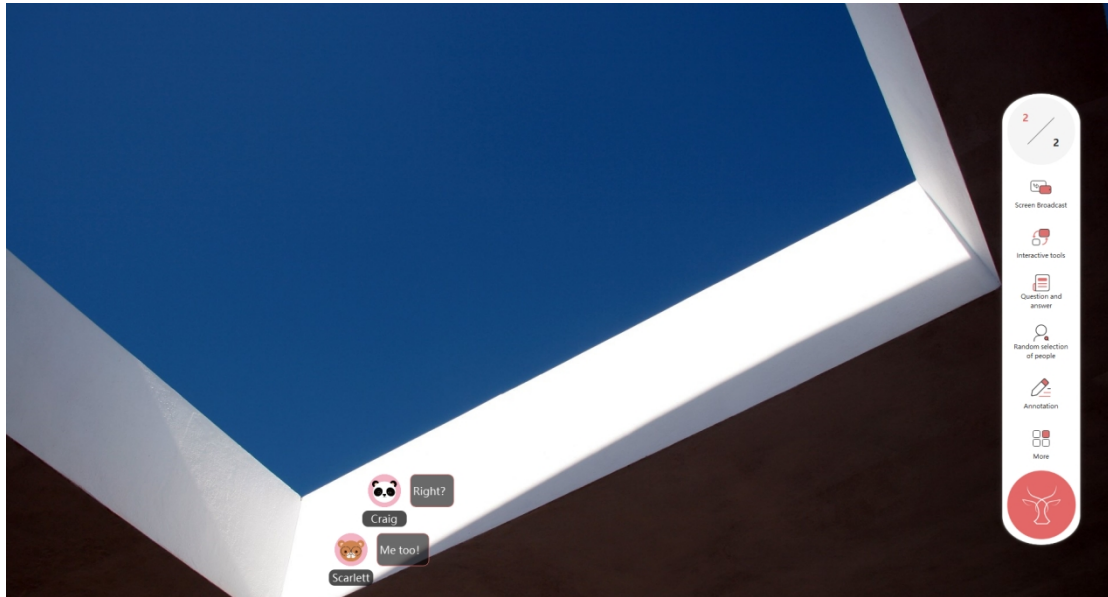


Group study members submit topics: View discussion content submitted by group members for comparison



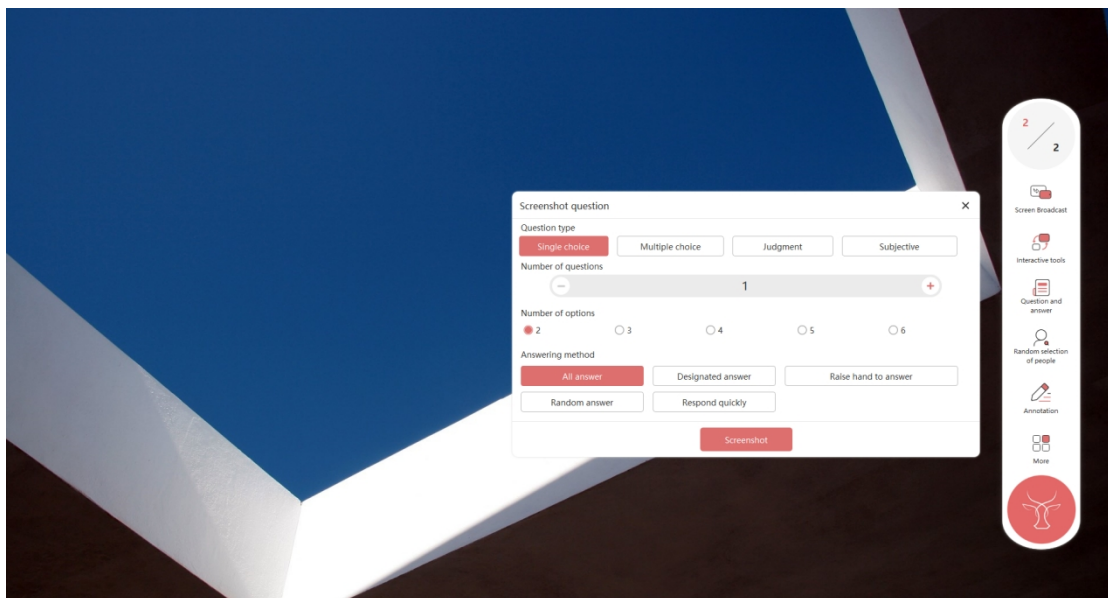
2.2.3.5 Bullet Comments

Enable to scroll bullet comments on the large screen

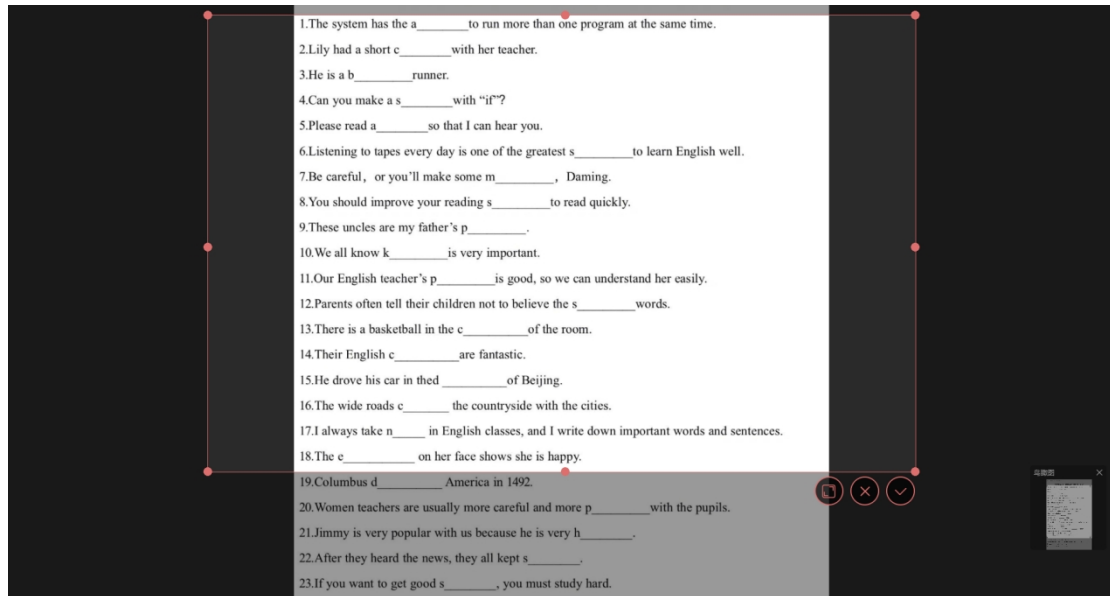


2.2.4 Question Setting and Answering

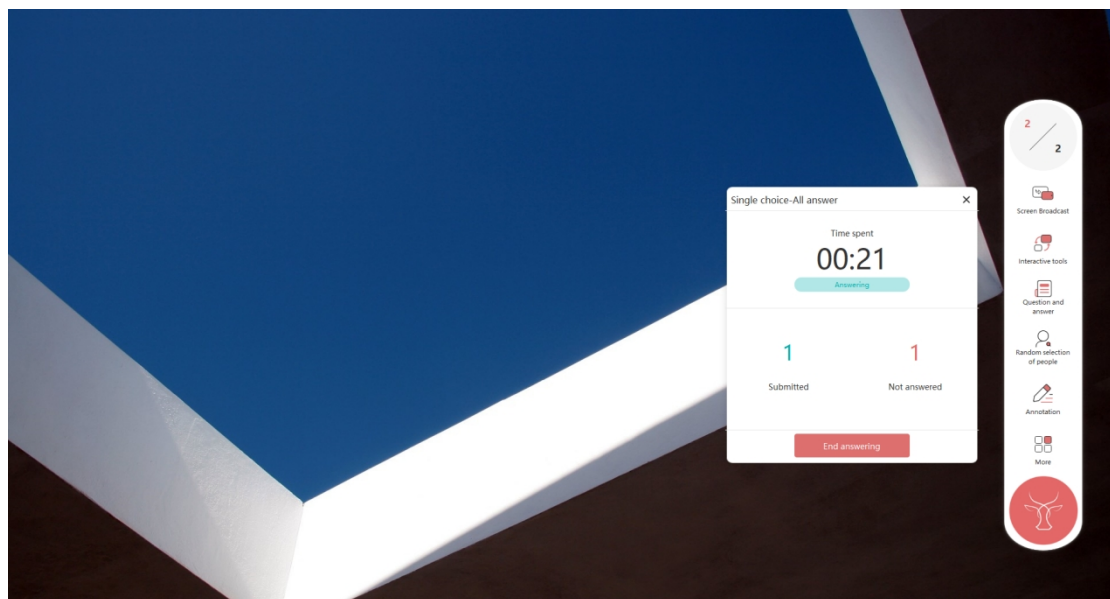
In class, you can use screenshots to create questions for practice. You can set the question types, quantity, and answering methods.



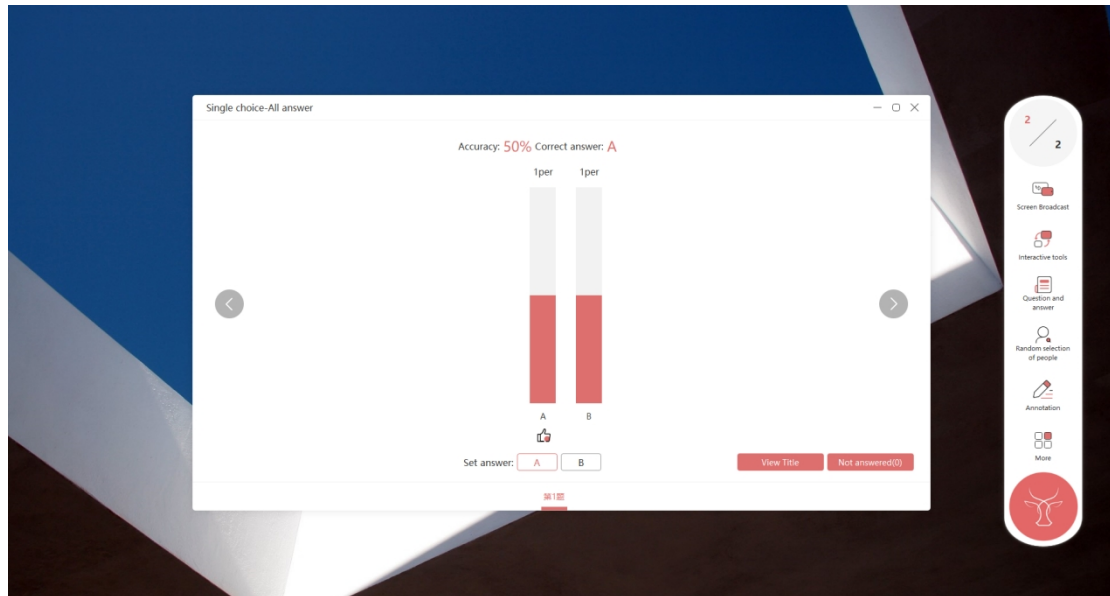
Click the screenshot button to display the screenshot area in the interface



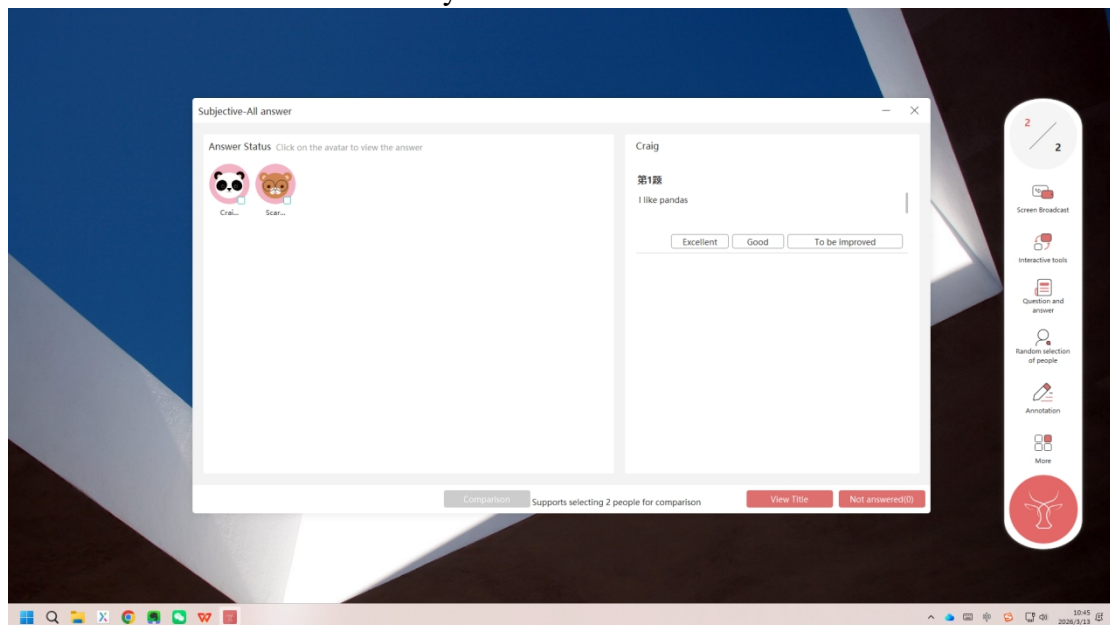
After submitting the question, you can view the student's answers. Click the End Answer button to enter the answer result page.



Answer page: Shows feedback content



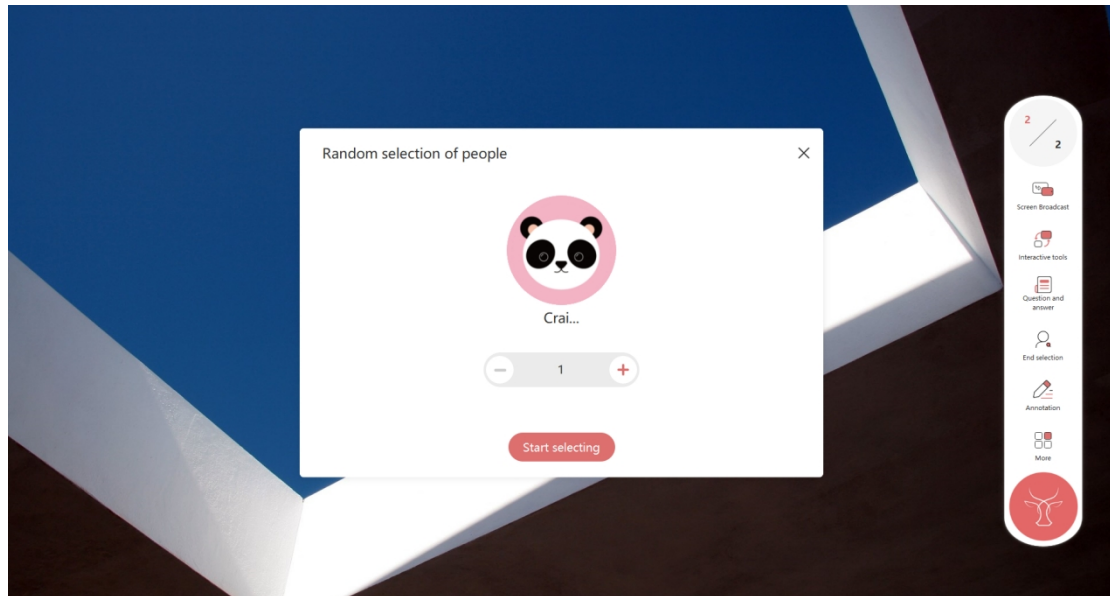
Subjective questions: After completing the answers, the result page displays the details of the answers submitted by students. Click the student's



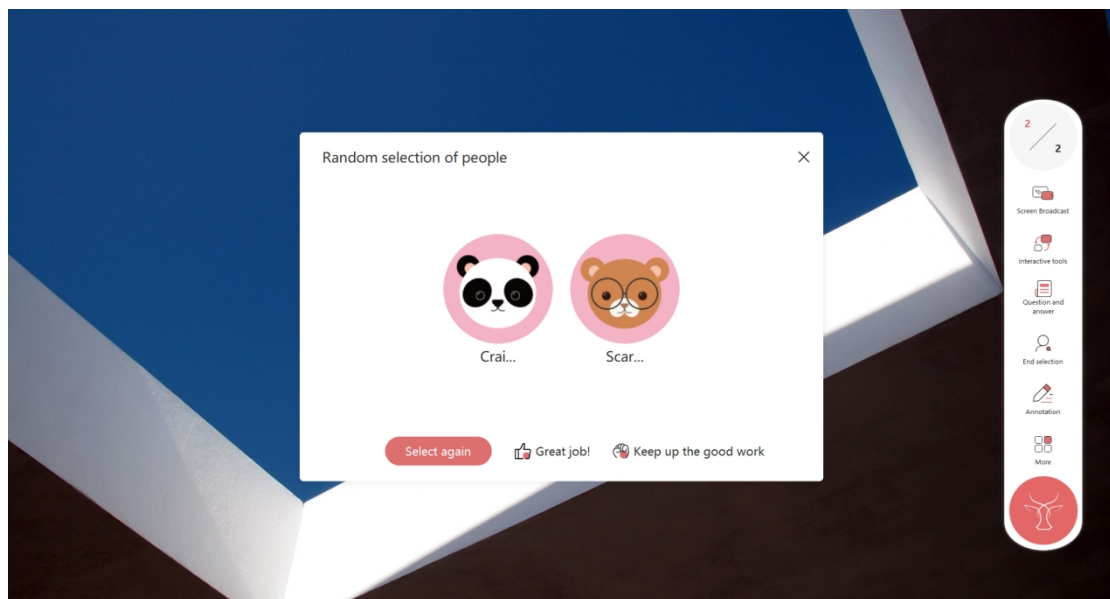
profile picture to view answers from different students.

2.2.5 Random selection of personnel

Select users randomly. Click the + or - button to adjust the number of selected users (default is 1). After clicking the Start Selection button, the interface will randomly select online class members. Click Stop to select students.

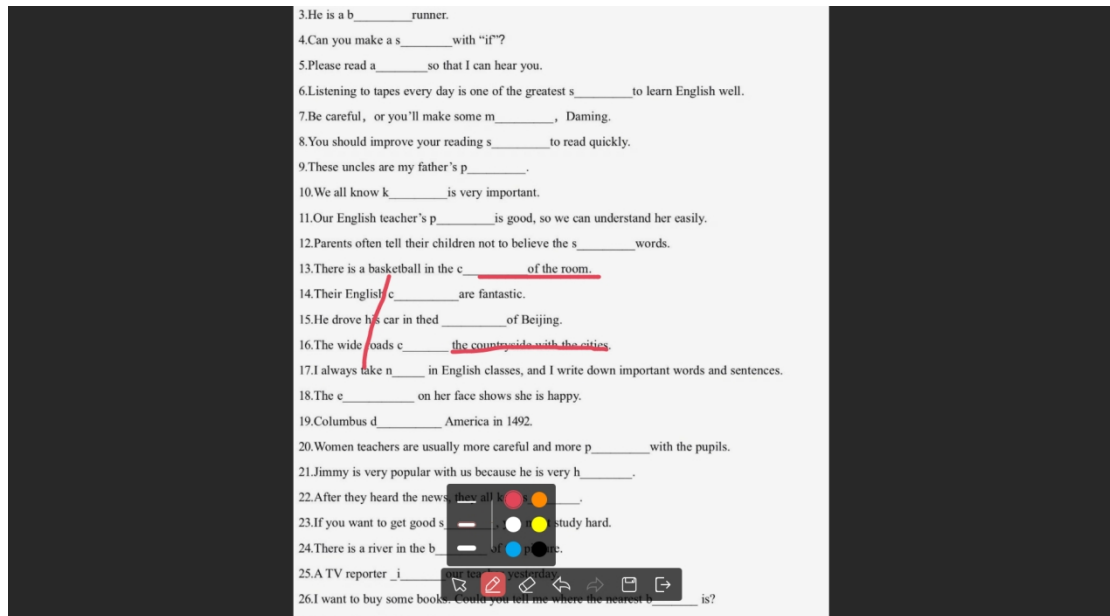


Select multiple people randomly. After selection, click the selected students to evaluate them.



2.2.6 Comments

Use the annotation tool to write comments on any page with different colors and pen thicknesses. Click to select, and you can operate the screen without exiting the annotation. Erase, undo, and restore your writing. Save your annotations.
